From Monster Catfish such as Paraiba, Giant Redtails and Jau catfish, to the Majestic Arapaima. Plus several other predatory fish, Vampire Payara fish, Peacock Bass, Arowana Fish, Piranha's Etc. Etc.



Fishing has always played a major role in my life, having learned the craft from my father and many others, having spent several nights over a few drinks listening to stories both fact and fiction about the one that got away will always haunt me..... and keeps me coming back for more.....

Piraiba Lodge

Is the oldest lodge on the river and has been here over 20 years, hand made and cut from the standing trees right there onsite. The craftsmanship of the Amerindians is amazing. Each length of wood precisely cut with a chainsaw, using various hardwoods including Purple Heart and Green Heart.

The lodge has in room Showers, Toilets and wash basins. Clean Towels and Bed Linen provided daily. Laundry is done daily.

Bedrooms sleep two, based on double occupancy, we can cater up to 12 guests. Comfy mattress, mosquito (princess) nets and 110 wall sockets on hand for your equipment / camera charging needs.

Food, varies from traditional Guyanese and Amerindian meals prepared in the kitchen. Three meals a day including packed lunch and beverages. Snacks and fruit will also be provided.

Please let me know on booking if you have any Food allergies or special requirements.

A mixture of soft drinks, fruit juices, energy drinks, coke and coke zero will also be provided

Alcohol will be included at an additional charge; however, this is limited to Guyanese / Brazilian beers dependent on availability. Spirits will also be included such as Rum. Again, please let me know if you prefer other drinks and I will check on availability prior to trip.





Transfers and Schedule

Day 1: Arrival in Guyana – Cheddi Jagan International Airport (GEO) or Ogle International Airport. Collection from Airport to the Hotel. (or Associate Hotel) depending on availability. Based on Double Occupancy.

Day 2: Early morning Departure from Hotel to Ogle Airport for flight into Jungle (approx. 1hr 15min flight) (*Maximum Combined Luggage Weight 44lb*) followed by 1hr scenic boat ride to Piraiba Lodge. Relax at camp and Setup Rods etc.

Day 3 – 10: Eight Full Days of fishing

Day 11: Early morning departure from camp to Airstrip and flight back to Ogle Airport. Transfer to Hotel and Overnight stay,

Day 12: Transfer to Cheddi Jagan International Airport (GEO) or Ogle International Airport for journey home.



Cost Breakdown

Cost Per Person \$\$\$ PLEASE CONTACT. Costs are based on Double Occupancy at Hotel, Lodge, and sharing boat with second angler.

Included: Transfers from Cheddi Jagan and Ogle International Airports and two nights accommodation at the hotel with continental breakfast. (one night prior to jungle trip, one night after trip). Flight to and from Iwokrama Village / Fairview landing strip, 9 nights at camp, 8 full days fishing with local Amerindian guide, three meals a day, water, soft drinks and daily laundry service.

Not Included: Beer and spirits at camp (**additional \$200 for unlimited**), International Airfares To and From Guyana, Hotel stays outside of Guyana, Taxi transfers outside of Guyana, Meals and Beverages at Hotel before and after trip, Medical costs (medical advice, medications and inoculations etc for your trip) Fishing Tackle.

Tipping: we insist on **\$200 USD** Per person tips to be divided between guides and camp staff. **Amerindian Village Community Landing Fee \$30** Per Person

Payment Terms: 50% on Reservation, 50% due 60 Days before trip start date.
