Our Mission is to eliminate modern slavery one person at a time. We work to prevent human trafficking through education, rescue trafficked individuals through intervention, and restore human dignity through affirmation.

Greetings Dear Family, Friends, and Supporters,

We have had an amazing four years of preventing Human Trafficking in our community through education! It's hard to believe that in 4 year we have educated over 14,000 children in the Pee Dee region! We have had the honor, privilege and given the right to educate in Schools, Churches, Civic organizations, and hospitals, throughout our community this year! I am so proud to call our community my home. The amount of support that this organization has been given is overwhelming. Human Trafficking has been in the dark for so long that only by acknowledging it, confirming that it exists has brought it to light. And this has been done by YOU!

"When The Community Get's Involved Trafficking Is Reduced!"

I have often been asked "why I do this?" My answer is and will always be, to prevent children from this horrific crime and in obediance to His calling. You see God started speaking into my life about Human trafficking 5 years ago when He sent me to India. I got to work and share the gospel with prostitutes in the district of Navi Mumbai-based in Turbhe Red Light slum. There I was able to see victims of human trafficking living in bondage, some as young as 8 years old. This nearly broke me. I was crushed in spirit, outraged, frustrated, and angry with God for bringing me to this place of evil influence. Then, I got an epiphany that I wasn't there to save anyone but I was there to be used by God so that He could. It would be six months later I would get the opportunity to visit Phnom Penh Cambodia in the Red light district there and I learned that it is easier to prevent human trafficking through education than it is to rescue. I prayed and asked God how can I prevent just "One" child from enduring this kind of evil. January 18, 2018 "One Child at a

Time" was founded. With your continued Help and support we can eradicate this evil together!

Rehab's Risk

Rehab's Risk is a community project started by One Child at a Time in which women and young girls in need are provided with basic supplies they may not have access to. These supplies include: toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, feminine products, clean underwear, clean water, food. These supply packages also contain educational material about human trafficking and how to get help. These packages are made possible through donations. These packages are distributed to local sex workers,



organizations like Pee Dee Coalition, House of Hope, The Palmetto Center, and The Florence County Sheriff's Department in order to get in the hands of women who need it the most.

One Child At A Time partnered with the Florence Center and they helped us to remind our children in the community that you can have fun without devices!
















