Teaching Instructions for Human Trafficking Education

Step 1

Ask the students the following questions.

- 1) Do you know what Human Trafficking is? Give them time to answer.
- 2) Raise your hand if you have the following social media sites and apps (1)Snapchat, (2)Facebook, (3)Instagram, (4)TikTok, (5)Weixin/WeChat.
- 3) Raise your hand if you play online games.
- 4) Raise your hand if you have ever talked to a stranger online.
- 5) Raise your hand if you have ever been shown or messaged any comments or pics that were inappropriate.

Today we are going to talk about how dangerous it is to talk to a stranger online. Reassure the student that you are not here to tell them technology is bad or that apps are bad but you are going to share with them that bad people use technology and these apps to get to YOU. I am going to show you how to be safe while your online with the help of Mrs. Skipper the Founder of a local non-profit called One Child At A Time.

Instruct students to pay attention to the following information. (At the end of the class YOU will be handing out FREE Tee-shirts/Bracelets from Ms. Skipper to the first student to raise their hand with the correct answer). The answers can be found in Step #4

- 1. Did you know: Anyone can be a Trafficker.
- 2. Did you know: Anyone can be a Victim.
- 3. Online predators target children between the ages of 10- 14 because they are easily manipulated, coerced, and easily controlled.
- 4. The top 2 methods of control by a trafficker are Isolation, and Emotional Abuse.
- 5. A runaway teen is the most vulnerable. A trafficker will pick up a runaway teen on the streets within 72 hours.

Step 2

Go to www.onechildrescue.com

Click on Education Tab at the top.

Click on schools and pick your grade on the tab that reads 6-8 or 9-12

Once you start the presentation. Let it play through.

Mrs. Skipper will give a short intro and then she will turn it over to the teacher to present the slide show and then a film.

(Instruct the students to pay attention the video. Five students will be chosen to receive a free tee shirt for the correct answer.)

Mrs. Skipper will close after video.

Step 3

Have students immediately fill out the Google Form

Step 4

You will all have supplies and handouts to give each student.

Printable information, and Human Trafficking Hotline number on the ONE card.

Have the students answer the following questions that you asked in Step 2. The first student to raise their hand with the correct information will receive a FREE Tee-shirt and bracelet.

- 1. Who can be a trafficked Victim? (answer- ANYONE)
- 2. Who can be a Predator? (answer ANYONE)
- 3. Why do online predators target children between the ages of 10-14? (answer they are easily manipulate, easily coerced, easy to control)
- 4. What are the top two methods traffickers use to control their victim? (answer- Isolation and Emotional Abuse)
- 5. How long before a runaway will come into contact with a Trafficker on the street? (answer- 72 hours)

Questions that have no prizes!

- 1. Raise your hand if you have heard the term "Sugar Daddy" or Sugar Baby? Did you know those are trafficking terms used by predators on all social media platforms.
- 2. Raise your hand if you have younger siblings, cousins, nieces/nephews? What would you do if they had strangers talking to them online like strangers talk to you? What do you need to do? (answer- educate them like Mrs. Skipper and I did today on how to be safe online).
