# TAILORED NAVIGATION SERVICES

We understand that caregivers often manage multiple responsibilities, even with an efficient platform. Our customized resource navigation service assists caregivers who may feel unsure about where to begin or need extra support. During an intake session, we listen to each caregiver's story and their family's unique challenges. We then provide a PDF summary with hyperlinks to the discussed resources for easy access. We also highlight organizations aligned with Slope Cares' mission, keeping caregivers informed about supportive entities committed to our shared goals.

## TAILORED RESOURCES THOMPSON FAMILY

### Medicaid Buy-In Program

Medicaid Buy-In is a program for children whose caregivers' income exceeds Medicaid limits. Ensuring they have access to state benefits.

### Children (HCBS) Waivers

These waivers serve children with physical and intellectual developmental disabilities to support caregivers and children so that they can remain in the care of their home. These waivers can offer respite, homemaker services and so much more!

### Assistance with Paperwork

Grand Valley Connects and Hilltop Family Resource Center can assist families with paperwork with required for Medicaid Buy-In and disability determination paperwork required for waiver applications.
