

Lyons for a better neighborhood coed softball tournament “The Duck Frenzy 500”

Co-ed (Men's and Women's) Softball Tourney

Location: At the Riverview Park immediately adjacent to the Lyons Grade School

DATE: August 14, 2021 Entry Fee - \$ 150.00

Each entered team must have a minimum of 5 men and 5 women on the field at all times along with 5 men and 5 women in the batting order.

If unable to field 5 men and 5 women in the field/batting order, each team must/could field a team with 6 men and /or 4 women on the field/batting order at all times, or 6 women and 4 men.

After each team plays any game in their time frame, after the game is completed, that team must provide one person to umpire on the bases.

A total of 8 teams will be allowed to participate in the tourney due to field availability, so the first 8 teams that register and provide the \$150.00 entry fee will be accepted to participate.

Prize money will be awarded for the first and second place teams in the winner's bracket, with prize money to be determined. There will not be a LOSER'S BRACKET. Lose and your team is OUT.

Softballs to be used will be 14 in. for men and 12 in. for women for offensive/batting purposes.

Due to time constraints regarding the completion of games, a 10 run or 5 completed innings, will determine the winner, due to the non-ability to have a lighted softball field.

Bats that will be used for the games will be provided due to some men and some women using bats that could be or would be determined to be illegal, or loaded, which could create a safety issue.

NO ROSTERS WILL NEED TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE PERSONS THAT WILL COORDINATE THE EVENT. THIS IS AN OPEN ROSTER.

Pitches called balls and strikes will be determined with a mat, using the unlimited arc rule.
