But the Elks Lodge might be called an Opportunity site for adding higher end development.



The Bomber property use to be an attraction in the area, but the WW2 Bomber which served as a cover over gasoline station and a restaurant alongside are no longer. The property I think is up for sale a few months back.



The Bomber property now sports a garden/nursery shop and a drive-up coffee chateau. But this property is most likely in the category of Opportunity site for more intense development.










The capital cost of these shelter units in the study area on Mcloughlin could be relatively inexpensive, I should think.





Only one storage facility serving a lot of residences in this study area.


