When Jess was five years old, she lost her mother to an accident and her father was sent to jail. Although she and her sisters were raised by her aunt, she found herself going from one bad relationship to another. Jess experienced significant abuse in these relationships and used drugs and alcohol to help her deal with the physical and emotional pain she was experiencing. At rock bottom Jess reached out to her aunt who raised her and asked for help. After completing a rehab program, Jess was able to move into Amanda's House, "I'm exactly where God wants me to be now!"

Although Jess has thrived at Amanda's House, she also acknowledges that it's been a transition. "I have had to learn how to be vulnerable, not be such a tough cookie. I don't have to be like that anymore." She also had to get used to the fact that people at Amanda's House really do care and want to help. "When you go from feeling so unlovable to being loved and cared for, sometimes it's hard to even believe it." Now she gets excited whenever she discovers that there are people who want to come alongside and help her and others. This help is already being put towards a bright







future. Jess would like to become a recovery coach "I want to help other people with stories like mine and help them in their recovery" Jess will soon begin training to became a certified recovery coach. Supporters of Amanda's House have made this possible for her through their donations.

Jess now regularly attends Restoration Church and has even had the opportunity to bring her kids, 11-year-old Miley and 10-year-old Jaelon, with her. "They think it's really cool!" Jess admits that for a part of her life she was really mad at God but now "he's such a huge part of everything I do."

When asked what she would like to share with the supporters of Hope United and Amanda's House, Jess gets emotional. Similarly, to how she feels about asking for help from those at Amanda's House, she still has trouble believing that there are people who want to help her. "There aren't enough words. And there aren't enough thank yous."
