- (1) Tell us your name and account number.
- (2) Describe the error or the transfer you are unsure about, and explain as clearly as you can why you believe it is an error or why you need more information.
- (3) Tell us the dollar amount of the suspected error. We will investigate your complaint and will correct any error promptly. If we take more than 10 business days to do this, we will credit your account for the amount you think is in error; so that you will have the use of the money during the time it takes us to complete our investigation.

Billing Rights Summary

In your letter, give us the following information:

- Your name and account number

How Finance Charge is Calculated For Your Home Equity Line of Credit

The balance subject to periodic FINANCE CHARGE is the sum of the daily balances of the Account as defined below, during the period covered by the statement ("billing cycle").
