

ROCKY POINT FIRE/EMS BOARD

All Board members, 12 guests, and fire chief (via phone) attended the June meeting, beginning with the budget hearing. After discussion and clarification on several items, it passed unanimously, as did the minutes of the previous meeting. Because the May meeting was cancelled, the Board examined the previous 2 months of records for the treasurer’s report, which also was unanimously approved.

From the Board, the department will enter into a cooperative agreement with the Forest Service to receive compensation for services it provides to that agency.

Old business consisted of again addressing the job description for Rocky Point Fire Chief. Three versions were submitted, with the Board focusing on the SDAO version. After clarifying a list of concerns and reminding one another that this description needs to focus on credentials and skills needed for any fire chief, not a specific person, the Board unanimously approved the description.

The single new business item was the approval of the budget.

Chief’s report included information on the department’s OSHA visit, Best Practice discounts, fire engine damage during a response to Lake of the Woods, and plans

to meet with the Forest Service to remove trees at LOW that interfere with access to emergency locations.

The Board approved a resolution to redirect certain funds to be designated for an upgraded ambulance.

Discussion followed on the department possibly holding several smaller events, in lieu of the annual Summer Festival, to generate some income lost from the cancelled fundraiser.

For the VFA, Linda reminded everyone of the monthly newsletter from the association, available at the fire department kiosk. After comments in Good and Welfare, the meeting adjourned.
