Jimmy Buffett is coming to the MGM Grand, in Las Vegas, NV on **October 19, 2019.**

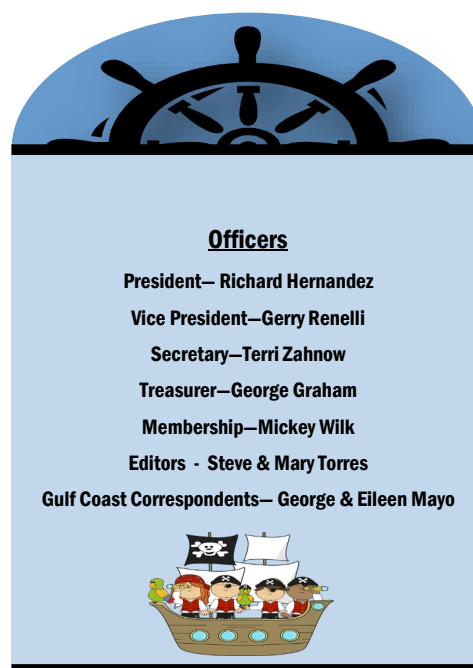
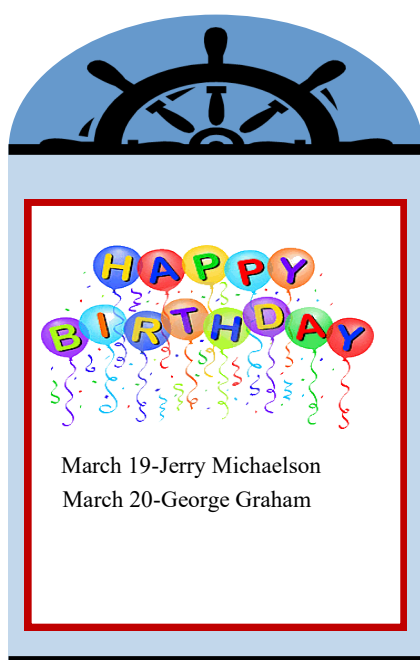
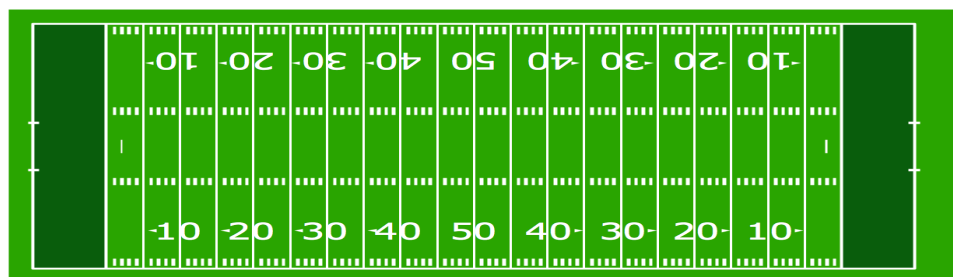
