Age 3 Solomon, KS Diagnosed June 2024 Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia

Macie's symptoms began subtly after her second birthday. The family had been battling a cold in early May, and while Macie's persistent cough was concerning, it didn't seem alarming at first. A visit to the walk-in clinic led to a diagnosis of allergies.



But soon, Macie's condition worsened. She started experiencing random fevers, complaining of being cold even in the summer heat, and showing signs of lethargy outdoors. A week before her diagnosis, Emily, Macie's mom, noticed a swollen lymph node in Macie's neck and a distended tummy, which was initially brushed off as weight gain.

The night before her diagnosis, purple dots appeared on Macie's lower legs. Emily's concern grew, and a quick search on Google made her realize the symptoms

could be much more serious than they had imagined. The next

morning, Emily took Macie back to the walk-in clinic, where the doctor quickly referred them to Children's Mercy in Kansas

City. It was there that Macie was diagnosed with Acute

Lymphoblastic Leukemia.

Since then, Macie has faced numerous challenges, battling infections and illnesses—including a near-fatal infection in her port that led to septic shock. The family now makes regular trips to Kansas City for treatment, often traveling two to four times a week. If all goes as planned, Macie will complete two more months of Frontline therapy and continue Long-Term Maintenance until her treatment ends in September, 2026.

Despite the hurdles, Macie's spirit remains unbroken. She's full of energy, sass, and determination—riding her bike, wrestling with her older brother, playing dress-up, and caring for her dolls. Her four-year-old brother, Henry, is her biggest supporter, always by her side and cheering her on.

Nothing will slow this warrior down!

Warrior Wagons

Our Warrior Wagons are packed with love and support. Each wagon is a large,

canvas cart filled nearly 4 feet high with toys, activities for the childhood cancer warrior and their siblings, blankets for the entire family, Love, Chloe awareness items, restaurant gift cards, stuffed monkeys, toiletry bags, and much more. On average, each wagon is valued at \$1,500.

Once the family empties the wagon, it becomes an invaluable tool for carrying their warrior or luggage in and out of the hospital.

Our wagons are often one of the first items we provide when we learn of a child's diagnosis. They never disappoint and bring joy during a family's biggest challenge.



Financial Support Grants


Our Financial Support Grants are available once annually to Kansas families with a child undergoing cancer treatment or in follow-up care. These grants typically average \$1,500, though the amount may vary depending on available funding.

The grant can be used for any family need—whether it's covering utilities, maintaining a vehicle, or fulfilling a special bucket list item. Regardless of how it's used, the financial support is always deeply appreciated by the families we serve.

Requests for Family Support Increasing

In the last three years, requests for Warrior Wagons and Financial Support Grants have more than doubled.

While it's unlikely that more children are being diagnosed, it's clear that more



families are learning about our support services through hospitals and other sources. That said, we can't rule out that the increase may be due to a combination of both factors.

As the demand continues to rise, we need your support more than ever to ensure we can keep providing wagons and grants to Kansas families facing the challenges of a childhood cancer diagnosis.

Monkey in My Chair

Monkey in My Chair was created by Love, Chloe founder, Heidi Feyerherm-Smith in 2009 to honor her daughter, Chloe, who loved school and monkeys. Combining the two to keep kids in treatment connected to their classmates was a perfect fit!

What began in her living room as an idea has now become known world-wide. On average, 800 kits are sent annually across the United States, Canada, New Zealand, Australia, Ireland, and most recently, Japan!

card to families.

These gas cards are funded through our Fueling the Fight distinctive license plate, available throughout Kansas. When you purchase or renew a Fueling the Fight license plate, a \$50 donation is required in addition to your yearly tag fees. The entire donation goes to Love, Chloe and is used to purchase gas cards for families.


CROP, CRAFT & QUILT 2026

Warrior Wagon Delivery Van Needed Will You Help?

With Warrior Wagon requests on the rise, we try to deliver more than one at a time if the wagons are in similar locations. This saves us the costs of gas and time out of the

office. However, finding transportation that will fit two wagons is difficult.



When finished, the wagons are approximately 4' tall, 2' wide, and 3' long. We are unable to fit more than one wagon in an SUV. Our remedy In the past has been to rent a cargo van which adds a significant cost to the delivery. We've also used a pickup truck when the weather allows, but we find ourselves stopping to adjust the tarp and tighten the ties several times.

A large van to deliver wagons would be a blessing. It would give us a vehicle that can

fit two, possibly three, wagons at a time. In addition, the van can be used to deliver Monkey in My Chair components to volunteer locations and to help transport items to event venues.
