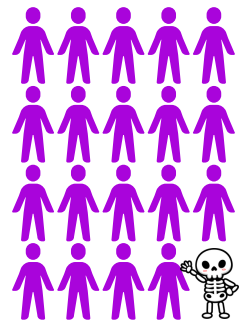

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Each year in Australia, around **1 in 20** children will experience the death of a parent before the age of 18 – a global trend. Put into perspective, at least 1 child in every classroom is grieving the death of a parent (ABS 2010; Feel the Magic NGO 2022).



Aim: Build teachers' confidence to talk about death and grief early, before a crisis occurs, and connect grief education to curriculum and student wellbeing, using the LightsOut eLearning program as the practical framework.

Rationale: This LightsOut Teachers Workshop supports educators to bring grief-aware learning into the classroom in a safe, age-appropriate and practical way.

Context: Grief affects learning, behaviour, relationships and wellbeing. Schools are often the first place where changes become visible, but students benefit most when grief education begins before a crisis occurs.
