

## THE ZARRELLA AWARD

Beginning with the 1986 National Duckpin Youth Championships, an award called the Zarrella Award has been presented at the National Tournament. The Zarrella Award goes to the National Tournament bowler who bowls the most pins over his/her three-game average.

The award is named for Tom and Ray Zarrella who owned and operated the Garden City Lanes in Cranston, Rhode Island for 32 years. After the bowling center closed in 1985, a banquet was held for Tom and Ray and some money was contributed to the National Duckpin Youth Association for the creation of this everlasting award in Tom and Ray's names.





## The Myra Pyles Sparemaker Award


The bowler who rolls the most spares in this weekend's tournament will win the Myra Pyles Sparemaker Award and receive a plaque at the awards banquet!
