

## TAKE BACK UNNEEDED OR EXPIRED MEDICATIONS DAY IS SATURDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2025

The Elks DAP promotes a take-back of unneeded prescription and over the counter medications. The goal of the program is to provide a safe, convenient and responsible means for disposing of prescription and OTC drugs while educating the public about the potential abuse of medications. NATIONAL DRAWN TAKERACK TAKE BACKS

If you miss this one-day event, don't fret. The DEA provides a search engine to seek out year-round disposal sites near your Lodge or home.

The search engine allows you to search a -5, -10, -20, or -50 mile radius from your home or Lodge. Go to deadiversion.usdoj.gov/drug to find disposal locations.

Locally, the CVS Pharmacies in Gilroy and Morgan Hill have convenient drop boxes where you can safely dispose of unused and expired prescription and OTC medications.
