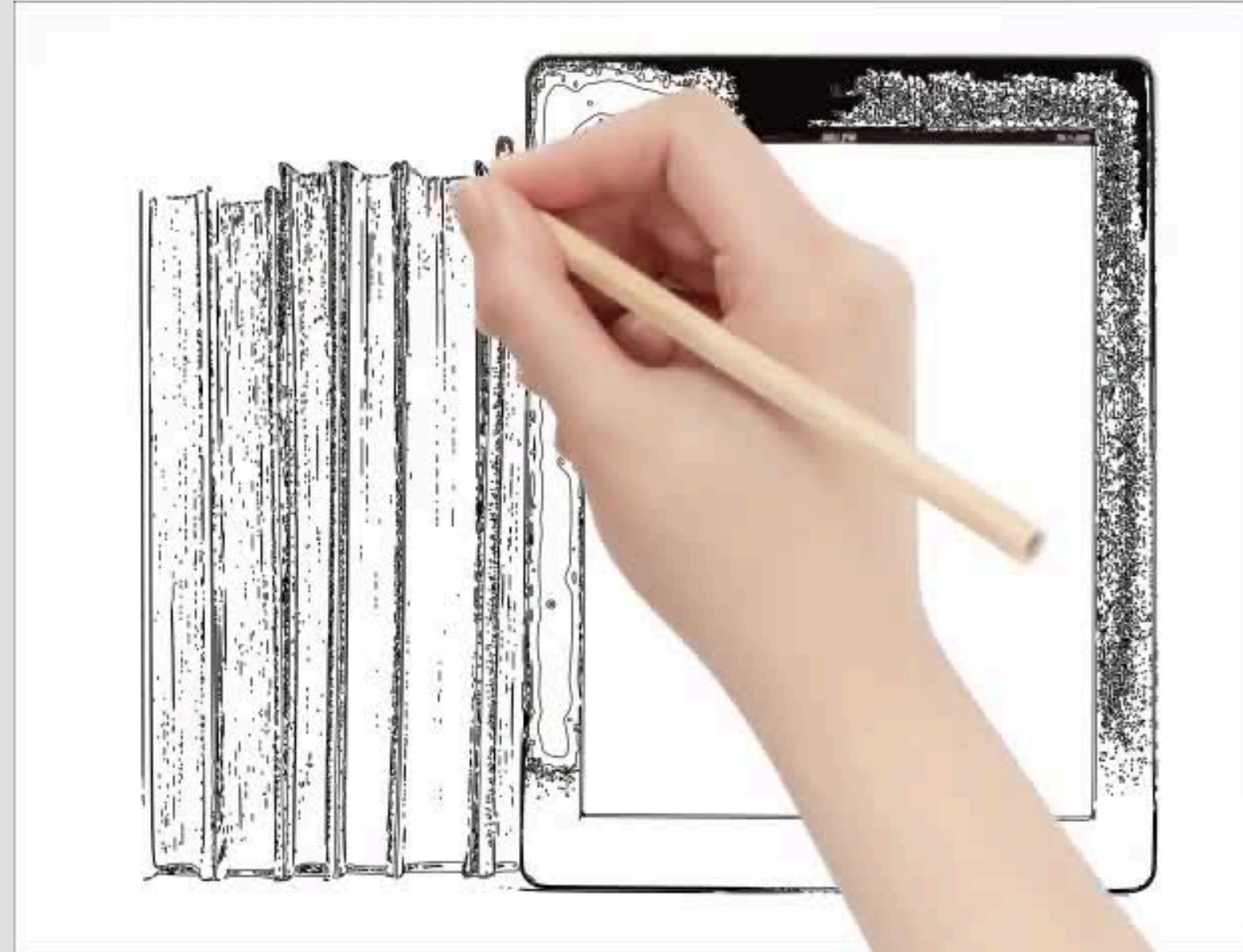

What is ePub?

- ▶▶ ePub (short for Electronic Publication) is a widely used open standard format for digital books and documents.
- ▶▶ It is developed by the International Digital Publishing Forum (IDPF) and maintained by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C).
- ▶▶ ePub allows text to automatically adjust to different screen sizes, making it highly versatile for e-readers, tablets, and smartphones.



Key Features of ePub

01

Reflowable & Responsive Text

Adapts to different screen sizes.

02

Supports Multimedia

Includes images, videos, audio, and interactivity.

03

Cross-Device Compatibility

Works on e-readers, tablets, and computers.

Lightweight & Portable

Small file size, easy to download and share.

Accessibility

Supports text-to-speech and font adjustments.

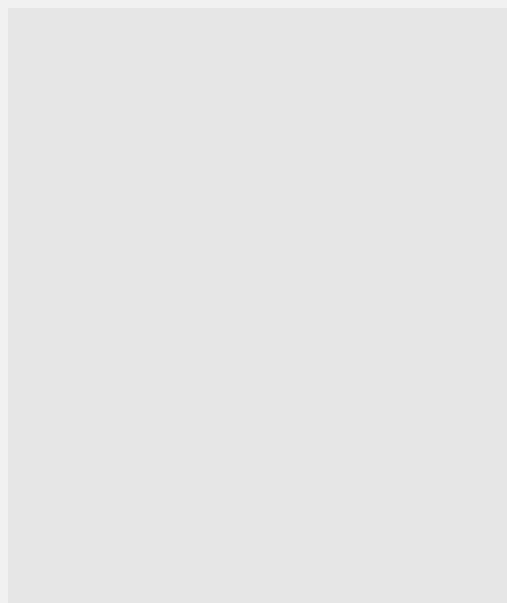

Step 1: Install Calibre

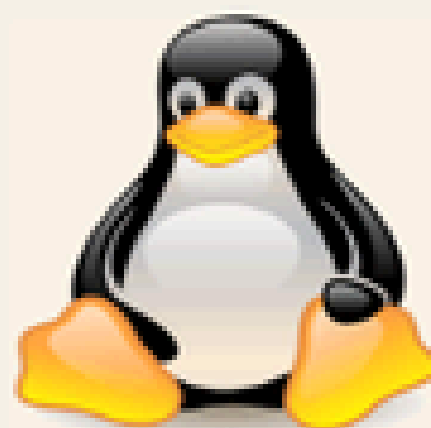

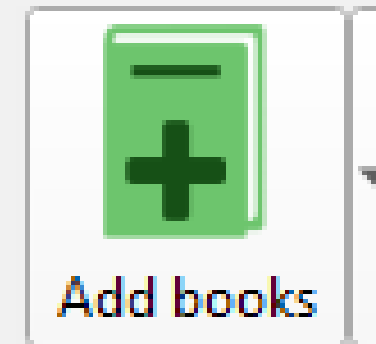

that contains your book’s content.

The file will appear in Calibre’s library.

Step 3: Convert to ePub

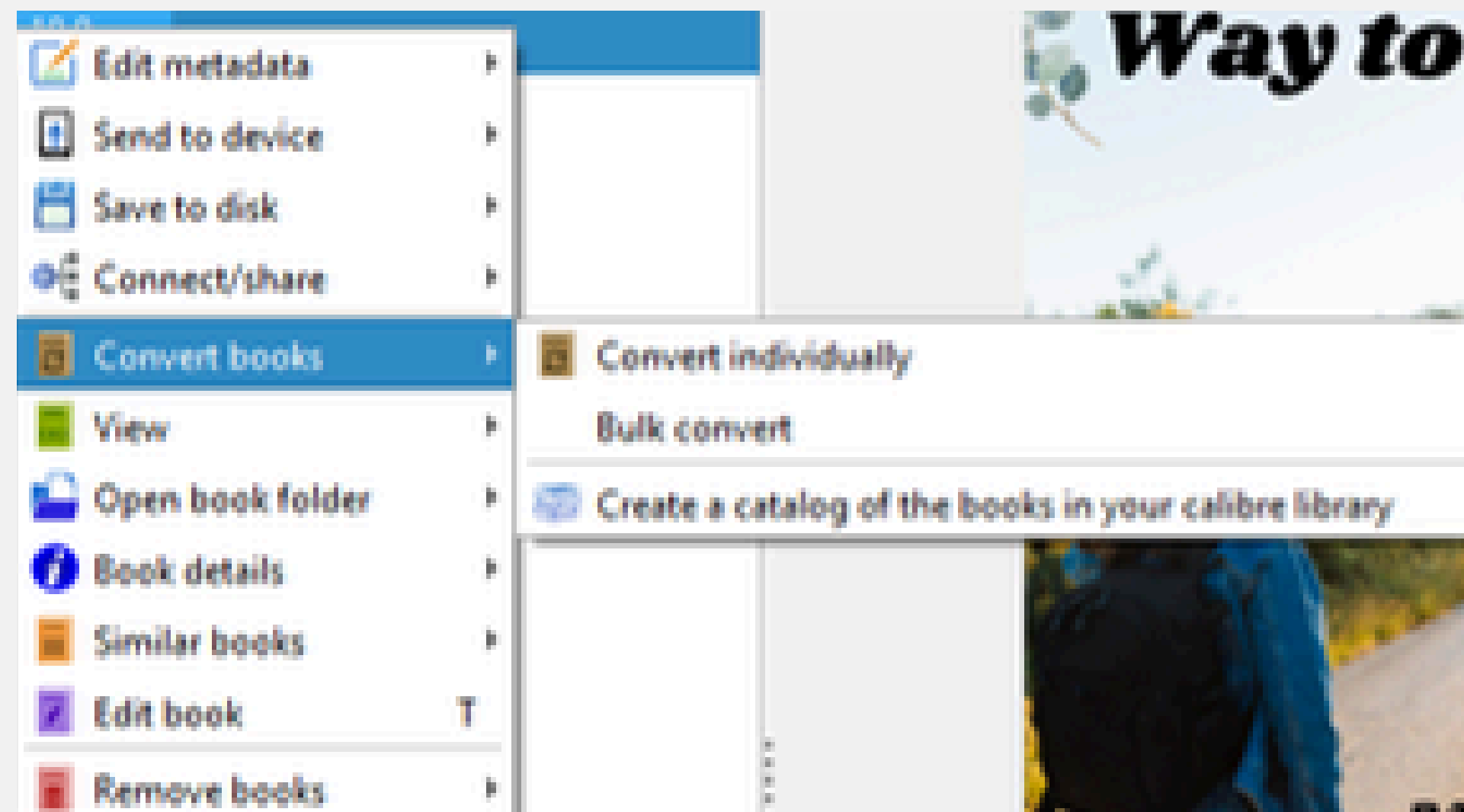

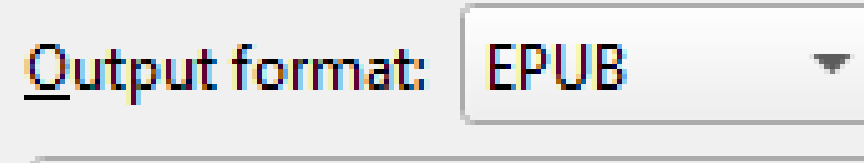
Click "Convert books" (single or bulk conversion).

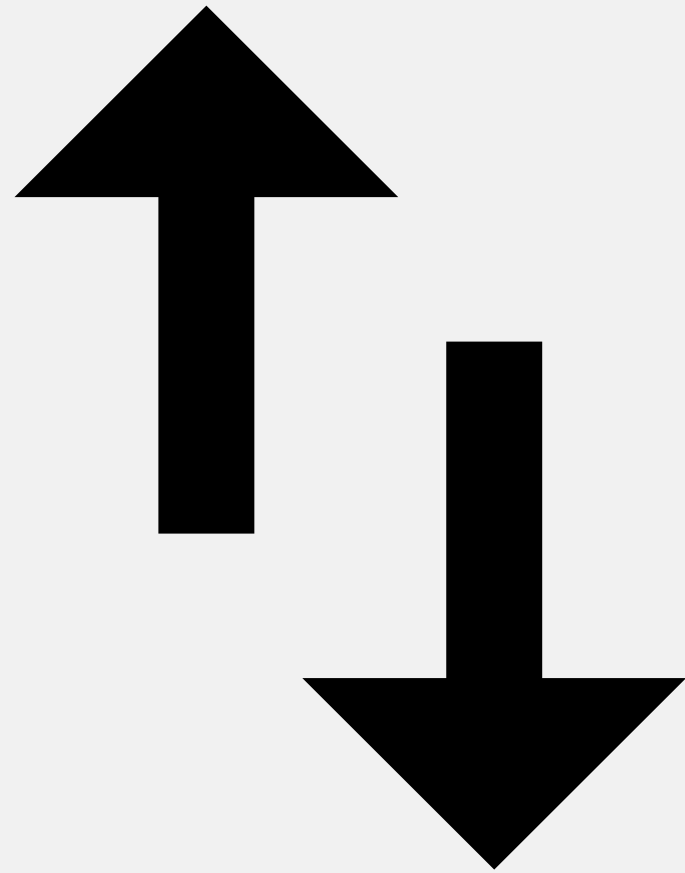
Adjust settings if needed:

- **Font & Layout:** Customize font size, margins, and spacing.
- **Table of Contents:** Adjust chapter headings.
- **Cover Image:** Upload a custom cover.

Click **OK** to start the conversion.

Step 4: Save and Export ePub File

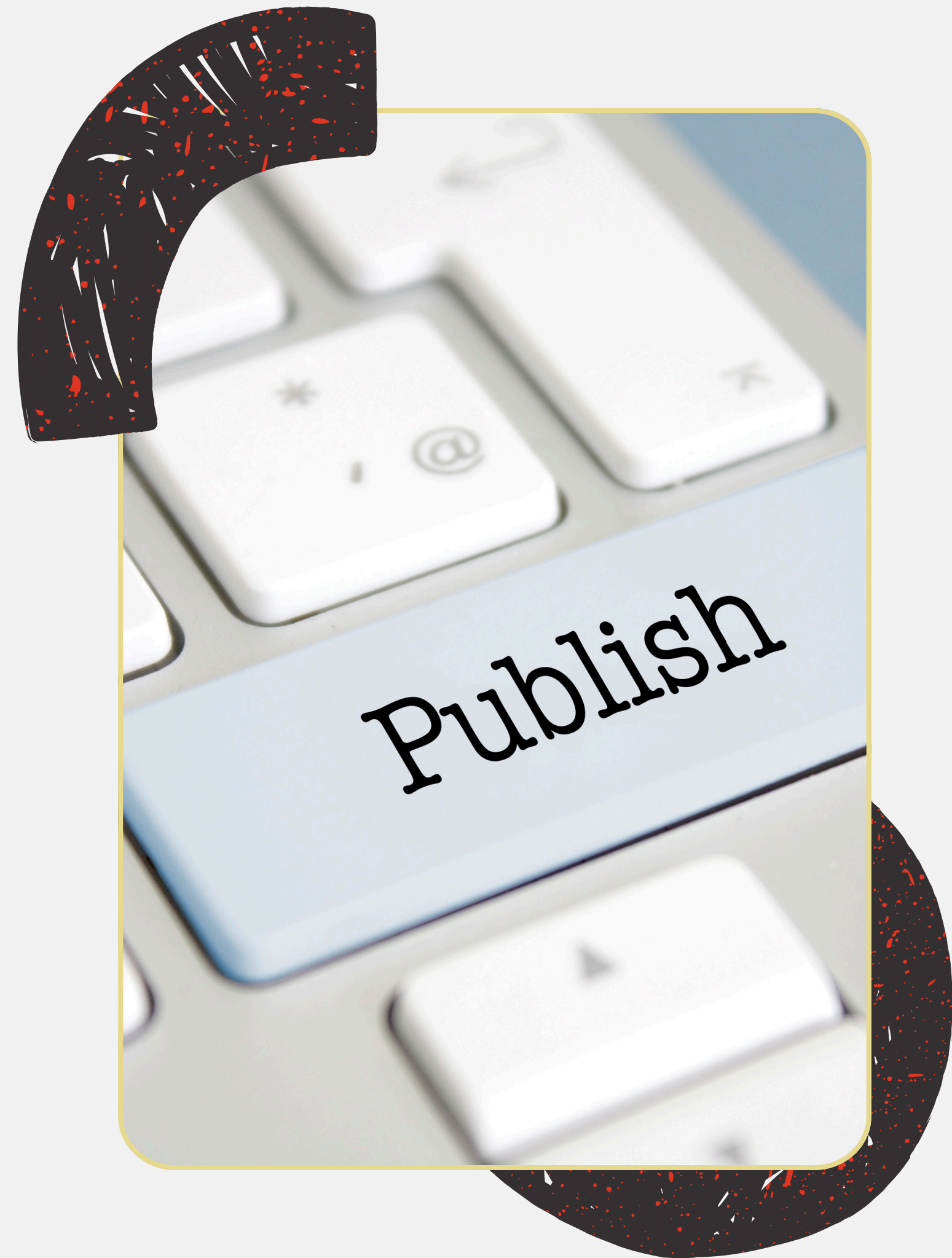
Once the conversion is complete, right-click the book and choose "**Open containing folder**".

The **ePub** file is ready to be shared, uploaded, or read on an eBook reader.

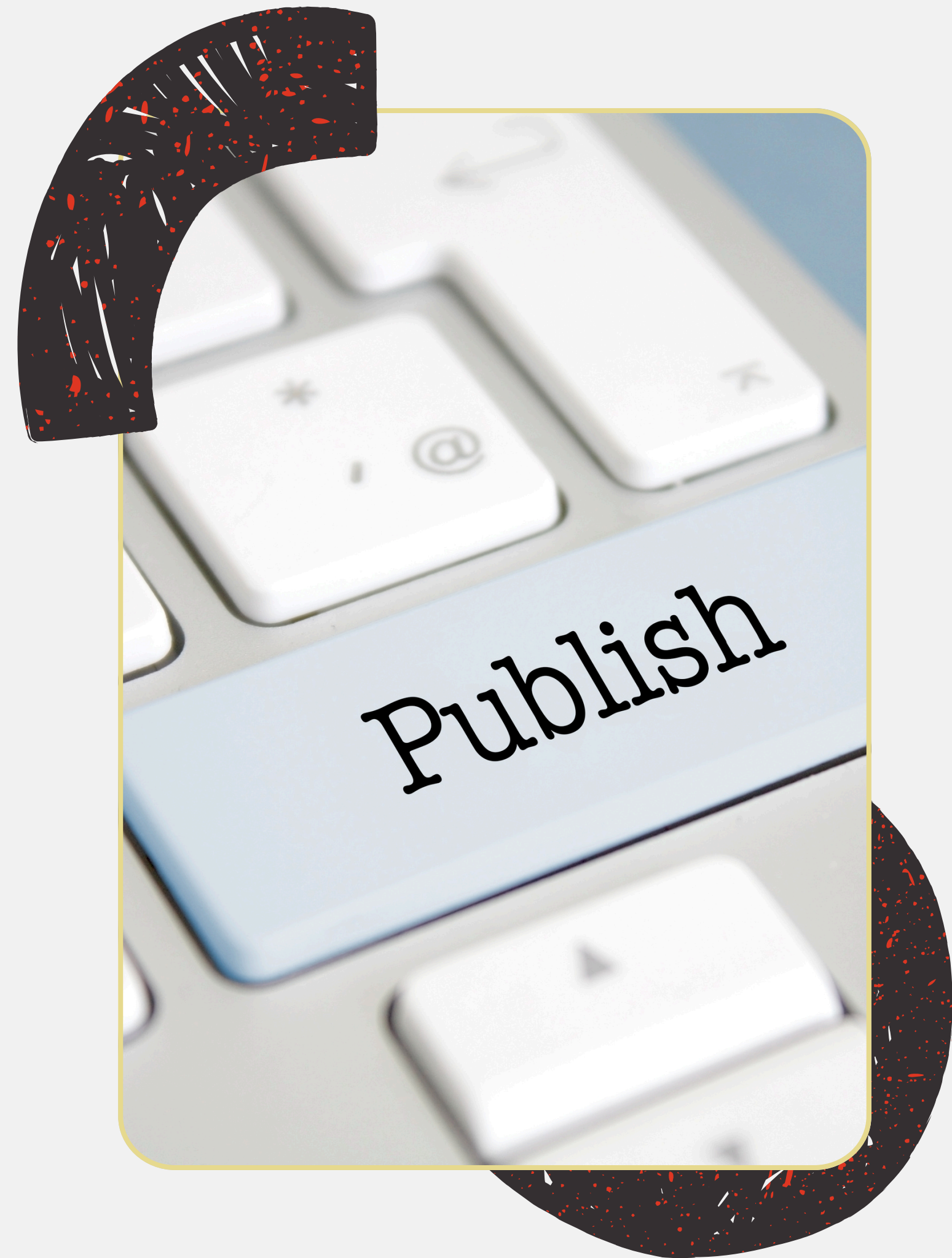


Pros and Cons of ePub



Pros:

ePub is a flexible, reflowable format that adapts to any screen, supports multimedia, and works with most eReaders. It offers accessibility features, customizable fonts, and small file sizes, making it ideal for digital reading.



Cons:

It is not natively supported on Kindle, requires conversion, and may struggle with complex layouts. DRM restrictions limit sharing, and it is not suitable for printing.
