Preamble To Statements of Faith

The Atlantic City Rescue Mission, being a mission and not a church, does not in these statements of faith seek to include the beliefs of its President/Chief Executive Officer, employees or Board of Trustees, however, all those associated with the Atlantic City Rescue Mission, in a responsible position, do adhere to and believe the following articles of faith.

Fundamental Statements of Faith

- 1. We believe in one God, eternally existing as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 2. We believe in the absolute Deity of Jesus Christ.
- 3. We believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross as a substitutionary sacrifice for our sins and that His shed blood is the only means for the remission of sins. He granted us eternal life through His resurrection.
- 4. We believe that the scriptures of the Old and New Testament are the inspired Word of God and that they are the supreme, final and only authority of faith and life.
- 5. We believe that man was created by God in God's image; he sinned as recorded in Genesis, causing physical and spiritual death.
- 6. We believe sin had its origin with Adam and as a result the entire human race is born with a sinful nature and is spiritually dead.
- 7. We believe that when a person receives by faith the Lord Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit regenerates that person into the family of God.
- 8. We believe in a future heaven for the saved and that it is not obtained as the result of good works, but we believe in the maintenance of good works and holy living as a result of salvation.

The Atlantic City Rescue Mission believes in the absolute inspiration of the Bible. We believe that faith in the Scriptures is absolutely necessary for a Christian testimony and to grow in grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ.

- 7. Have the ability and desire to work in harmony with other staff members.
- 8. Not have been a client at the Atlantic City Rescue Mission within the three years prior to date of application.
