Discipline Policy

The Lord's Army recognizes that discipline is a key role in creating boundaries and maintaining a safe environment for children to thrive in. Our ability to maintain a happy healthy school is top priority.

If a child is endangering others (throwing, kicking, hitting, biting, using inappropriate language) and is unresponsive to verbal redirection the child will be physically removed from the space they are in and relocated to a soft safe environment where they can privately but with in sight of a staff member safely blow off steam. Once we are able to communicate with the child again, we will discuss safety, respect and kindness to other students and staff. If the child's behavior continues to persist, we may contact a parent for pick up.

We will always do our best to engage your child into activities and attempt to solve the dispute by use of words with one another and working through social constructs. However continual offenses must be resolved at home by parents. We are grateful for the opportunity to support you and develop a plan to move your child forward and continue our educational plans.

Children are growing evolving and seasons of disruptive behavior are normal. You will get through this and we will support you. Prayer and love and boundaries are the most important thing you can give your child to ensure their success.

The Lord's Army does not use corporal punishment and will never be the ultimate disciplinary figure in your child's life. This means you are, so work with us. Help us work with your child by communicating what is happening at home when needed and we will continue raising healthy happy stable children together.
