This is the EMS Event for 2021 Muster

This is a timed team event. Each member of the team will triage 3 of the patients. Time runs from the beginning of triage till the team leader notifies command of the initial triage numbers.

We will use START triage parameters for the event. A triage reference sheet is available for use during the event. The member triaging the patient will hold the reference sheet to indicate that they are triaging the patient on the screen.

The team leader will track the patients triaged and report the triage numbers at the end of the evolution.



SAMPLE

Scenario: Motor Vehicle Accident

Your company arrives at a multiple vehicle injury accident. The incident commander has assigned your crew to conduct triage of the injured people. The scene is safe and your crew is wearing appropriate PPE.

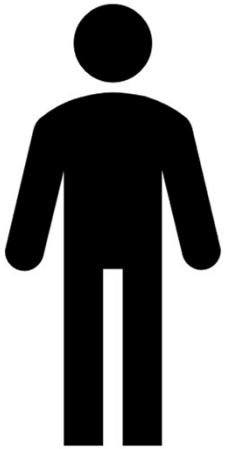
For this event, each member of your team will triage 3 patients. When you decide what color to triage the patient, tell the proctor the color and say "next patient". The proctor will then advance the slide to the next patient. You cannot go back and change answers.

Time will start when the next slide comes up.





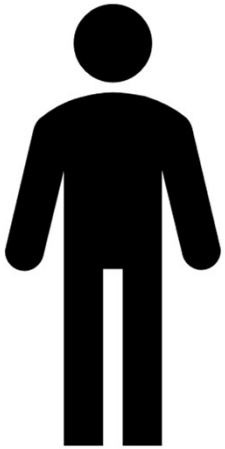
Patient 1: 23 y/o M

- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 24**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 100**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMANDS**
- **BROKEN R. ANKLE, CUTS AND BRUISES**



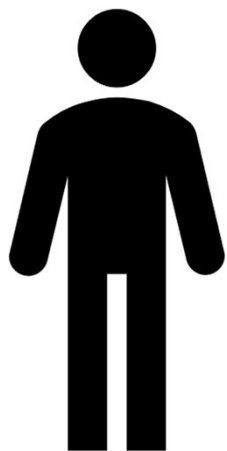
Patient 2: 45 y/o M



- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 20**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 88**
- **UNCONSCIOUS**
- **HEAD TRAUMA, BLOODY NOSE, HEAD LACERATIONS**



Patient 3: 21 y/o M

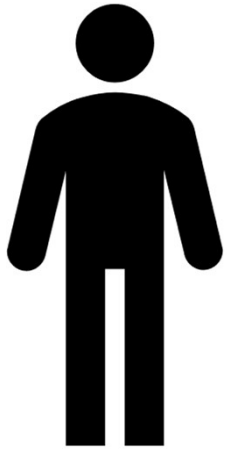


- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **NOT BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 0.**
- **RADIAL PULSE not present**
- **UNCONSCIOUS UNRESPONSIVE**
- **PINNED IN WRECKAGE, EXTRICATION WILL BE NEEDED**

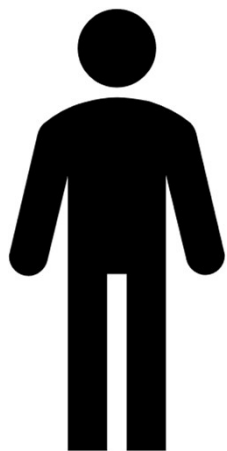
Patient 4: 33 y/o F



- **ABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 20**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 92**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMANDS**
- **SHOULDER PAIN, ABDOMINAL PAIN FROM SEATBELT**



Patient 5: 67 y/o F

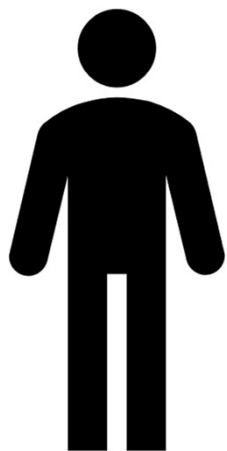


- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 34**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 100**
- **CANNOT FOLLOW COMMAND (SEMI-CONSCIOUS)**
- **LEG FRACTURES, HEAD LACERATIONS**

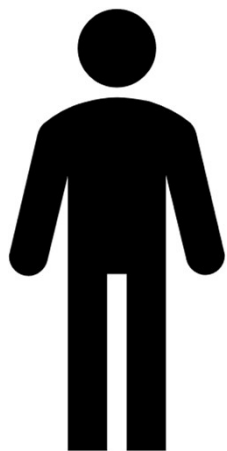
Patient 6: 29 y/o M



- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 20**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 96**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMANDS**
- **NECK AND BACK PAIN, R ARM LACERATION**



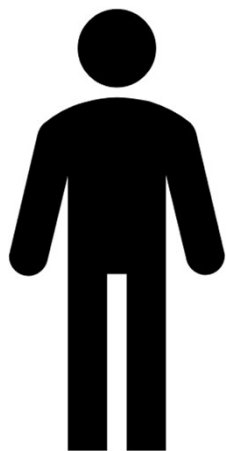
Patient 7: 30 y/o M



- **ABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 20**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 100**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMANDS**
- **L KNEE PAIN, HAND LACERATIONS**



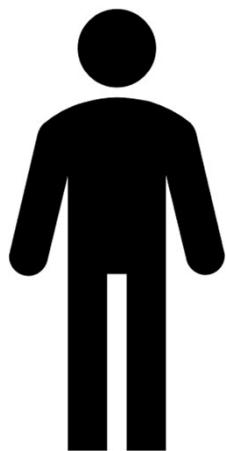
Patient 8: 78 y/o M



- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE IS 36 and Shallow**
- **RADIAL PULSE NOT PRESENT**
- **UNABLE TO FOLLOW COMMAND**
- **UNCONSCIOUS**
- **HEAD INJURY, L ARM FRACTURES,
BROKEN L LEG**



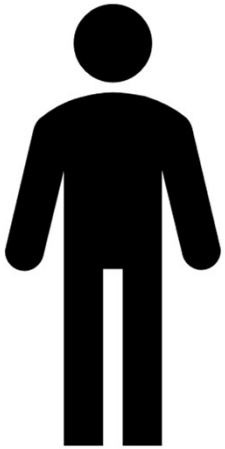
Patient 9: 44 y/o F



- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 24**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 100**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMANDS**
- **BACK PAIN, L ARM LACERATION**



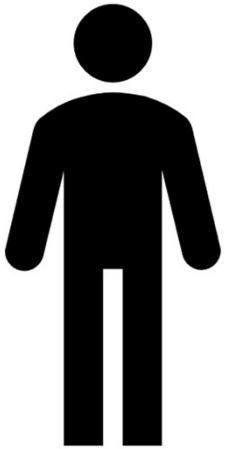
Patient 10: 51 y/o M



- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 10**
- **RADIAL PULSE is ABSENT**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMAND (SEMI-CONSCIOUS)**
- **RIB FRACTURES, BACK PAIN**



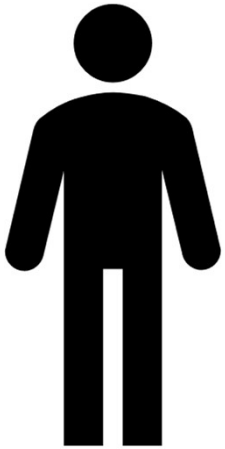
Patient 11: 12 y/o F



- **UNABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 24**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 108**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMANDS**
- **L KNEE PAIN, R SHOULDER PAIN,
ASTHMA HISTORY**



Patient 12: 35 y/o F



- **ABLE TO WALK**
- **BREATHING**
- **RESPIRATORY RATE is 20**
- **RADIAL PULSE is 96**
- **ABLE TO FOLLOW COMMANDS**
- **NECK/SHOULDER PAIN, CONCERNED FOR HER DAUGHTER**



Triage complete

Time Stops when team lead notifies command of the initial triage numbers.
