

MCI Expected Triage Results McKinley River Bar Fight

The following is the expected initial triage colors for this scenario.

#	Color	Reason
1		Resp rate, No follow commands
2		Able to Walk, Follow commands
3		Able to Walk, Follow commands
4		Not breathing, No pulse
5		Able to Walk, Follow commands
6		Not breathing, No pulse
7		Unconscious, No Follow commands
8		Unable to walk, Follow commands
9		Radial pulse absent, No commands
10		Unable to walk, Follow commands

MCI Scenario and Instructions McKinley River Bar Fight

Scenario: Your company is dispatched on a MCI response for a scene of violence at the McKinley River Bar. The caller reports multiple patients injured. PD is also responding to this incident. What should you do prior to arriving at the incident? (Stand by till the scene is secure by PD)

Your battalion chief arrives and establishes McKinley Command. Your company is assigned to perform initial triage once the PD has secured the scene. You have 1 minute to organize your crew.

Provide McKinley Command with your initial triage report when you complete triage.

Rules: Patients are randomly numbered for evaluation/tracking. One member must wear the triage belt or carry the triage kit. Place triage tape on the upper right portion of the patient card (with binder clip or paper clip). Penalties exist for the following:

Missing any patient (1 minute per)

Improper patient triage (15 seconds per)

Running or unsafe action (1 minute per)

Extraction, Treatment/Secondary Triage Option: (not at 2023 Muster)

After triage is complete, extract patients to a Treatment Area and re-triage to determine an order for transport.
