## **\*\*PART I SINGLES\*\***

- 1., Open to any Florida State 600 Club female member who holds a current USBC membership.
2. Singles is a 3-game classified scratch tournament. Open Division 185 & up; Class A 170-184; Class B 155-169; Class C 154 & under.
3. Participants may re-enter once in Singles. **Entrants in Singles event can only cash once.**
4. Walk-ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. Bring verification of average (See Rule 8). Check-in time is 45 minutes before squad starts.
5. Entries close MIDNIGHT. Saturday. September 12. 2026. Check-in 45 minutes prior to squad time. 1st CHOICE WILL BE HONORED UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTIFIED.
6. Entries will be scheduled as they are received. The tournament director has the right to schedule your squad if you have not made a choice or change your squad if necessary, and you will be notified of your changed/assigned squad time.
7. Averages used to classify divisions shall be: (1) the highest 2025-2026 winter USBC yearbook of 21 games or more; or (2) if no such average. 2026 Summer average of 21 games or more; or (3) current average of 21 games or more as of tournament closing date; or (4) if bowler has none of the above, an average based on the last 3 highest averages of 21 games or more as reported on [bowl.com](http://bowl.com)
8. Average will be verified by Tournament Director using [bowl.com](http://bowl.com)
9. Prize money will be paid back to 1 of every 5 entries. Prize money will be returned 100%.
10. **USBC CARD OR RECEIPT MUST BE PRESENTED WHEN CHECKING IN.**
11. USBC Rule 319a (3) will apply. **ANYTHING NOT IN RULES USBC TOURNAMENT RULES APPLY.**
12. Unattached membership or participation fee. Bowlers wishing to participate shall make applications through an official of the tournament and pay the required fee.

### **13. Bowling attire: Any suitable and proper attire, skirts or slacks preferred \* \*PART II.**

#### **HANDICAP LANE O'GRAM\* \***

1. All rules in Singles will apply if applicable.
2. Scores bowled in singles will be used for the Handicap Lane O'Gram scores.
3. Handicap will be computed at 100% of 220
4. This event will have a separate entry fee and prize fund.

# 3-6-9 NO TAP FRIENDSHIP DOUBLES/ALIBI EVENT

(An optional event for those bowling the State 600 Singles

Tournament) **SEND NO MONEY**

## **DOUBLES FEE ACCEPTED ONLY AT THE LANES**

There are 3 ways in which bowlers may sign up for the 3-6-9 No Tap Friendship Doubles/Alibi event.

- A: At any time during the tournament, bowlers may pre-register for any doubles squad listed below by filling out a recap card and paying the entry fee at the site. **IF BOWLERS ARE NOT PRESENT WHEN DOUBLES SQUAD BEGINS, THE PREPAID ENTRY FEE IS FORFEITED.**
- B: Bowlers may bowl on the 6 dedicated doubles lanes any time during the tournament on a first-come, first served basis, **UNLESS LANES ARE NEEDED FOR SINGLES.** Both partners must be present at the time the recap card is completed and entry fee paid and they will be assigned the next available dedicated lane.
- C: **ALIBI DOUBLES** —To participate you and your partner must be registered for the regular 3-6-9 No Tap Friendship Doubles and be bowling on the same doubles squad. One must be scheduled to bowl in the singles event. Two 600 Club members may bowl together, a 600 Club member and a non-600 Club member may bowl together, but two non-600 Club members may not bowl together. Non-600 Club members must have proof of average. (See Rule #8)
- D: There will be one division in the doubles/alibi event with a 375 combined average cap. It is the responsibility of the bowlers to be sure their combined averages do not exceed this 375 cap. **IF THE CAP IS EXCEEDED THE SCORES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND THE ENTRY FEE FORFEITED!**
- E: Prize money will be returned 100% at a ratio of at least 1 prize for every 5 entries. You may participate as many times as you wish but may cash only once with the same partner.
- F: One set of doubles cannot bowl alone.
