1. The installation of these tanks shall comply with all applicable regulations, laws and standards pertinent to underground fuel tanks, including but not limited to the 2018 International Fire Code (IFC) Chapter 23 (Motor Fuel-Dispensing Facilities and Repair Garages) and Chapter 57 (Flammable and Combustible Liquids), NFPA 30 and NFPA 30A.

2. Any changes from the approved and stamped plans must first be approved by the MIDStar Fire Marshal.

3. An inspection of each tank is required by this office prior to back-fill and a final inspection before use.

4. At least one 4A:60BC is required to be located in a weatherproof cabinet with appropriate signage within 75 feet of the dispensers.

5: It is the responsibility of the General Contractor to ensure that all subcontractors phone in their inspection requests accordingly. Inspection requests need to be called in to (208) 455-4703. Inspection requests need to include the project name / address or building permit number, name, call-back telephone number and/or email address, company name and the nature of the inspection or consultation.
