

REPORTING CONTACT INFORMATION Office of the Fire Marshal

FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM COMPLIANCE REPORTING (Sprinkler, Alarm, Commercial Hoods)

The Middleton Rural Fire District and the Star Fire Protection District utilize The Compliance Engine (TCE) www.thecomplianceengine.com to manage and track fire protection system inspection compliance.

Vendor Responsibilities:

- All fire protection system inspection, testing, and maintenance reports must be uploaded directly to The Compliance Engine.
- Reports must be submitted promptly upon completion. The Office of the Fire Marshal will not pursue vendors for missing reports.
- Failure to upload reports on time may result in an inspection failure for the premises.
- Reinspection fees will apply if a report is not submitted as required.

Important Upload Instructions:

- Ensure the report is uploaded to the correct physical address, including any applicable building letter or number.
- Inaccurate or incomplete location information may delay approval or trigger reinspection.

BACKFLOW PREVENTION REPORTS:

- Backflow test reports are required for systems connected to fire protection systems, including sprinkler and standpipe systems.
- Reports must be uploaded sent to the agency having jurisdiction in the same timely manner as other fire protection reports. Contact list provided below.
- Ensure the certified tester's information and the test date are clearly included in the report.
- Reports not submitted, or submitted late, may result in failed inspections and enforcement actions.
