From Our Zoning Officer

- *ALL docks with ice damage require permits.
- *ALL new construction over the water requires design professional's plans, base flood elevation report, DEP permit, liability insurance cert, zoning & building permits, etc.
- *A resident may divert water from property, but it may <u>NOT</u> be diverted onto someone else's property.
- *Permits are required for ALL development within the Borough. Development is defined as the division of a parcel into two of more parcels; construction, reconstruction, conversion, structural alteration, relocation, or enlargement of any structure; mining, excavation, landfill, or land disturbance; or any use or extension of the use of land.
- *Zoning Officer Hours: Monday, Wednesday & Thursday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.; direct phone line is 570-639-3302.
