_____ Test Option 2: \$185.00, plus cost of electronic fund transfer is payment is via Paypal or Venmo. Presence/ Absence Test for T. Coliform/ E. coli and Alkalinity (Total as CaCO₃), Chloride, Fluoride, Hardness, Nitrate as N, Orthophosphate, pH, Sulfate, Total Dissolved Solids, Turbidity, Metals including Aluminum, Arsenic, Barium, Copper, Iron, Lead, Magnesium, Manganese, Mercury, Nickel, Potassium, Sodium, Zinc, and more. This option includes a hardcopy of our educational booklet titled "Our Drinking Water" a \$20.00 value.

Instructions

1. Fill Out the Form. The sampling kit has two containers one for water quality and one for bacterial screen.
2. Collect the water samples on the morning of July 12, 2025. You may want to remove the aeration device on your kitchen sink and clean the sampling tap with 91 % alcohol before sampling. Allow the cold water to run for 15 minutes before collecting the sample.
3. Reduce the water flow from the sink to a steady stream and fill the bottles to the top. Please fill one bottle at a time. After collection, store the samples in the refrigerator.
4. Bring the sample to the Borough Building Packed on Ice or freezer pack in a "Ziploc bag" on July 12, 2025- between 10:00 am and Noon.
