REPORTS FROM APPOINTED OFFICIALS AND SPECIAL COMMITTEES Reports were given by the following committee chairs:

Grants: Dr. Fred Lubnow of Princeton Hydro asked the state for an extension on the grant for a rain garden at the Municipal Building, which will further reduce phosphorus. The Sunset Terrace project is moving forward. We're waiting to hear on the whole-lake hydrilla treatment and bacteria grant. A mini-grant for \$24,000.00 for extra hydrilla treatment and public information on the problem. Also Princeton Hydro applied for a 319 grant for a whole lake hydrilla treatment and stormwater management plan. We are on track to be 100% reduction of phosphorus. We're at about 75% right now. When we are at 100%, we can apply for dredging grants. The floating islands will be relocated and replanted by Fred's crew.

Roads: Bill Hilburt gave the report – Road crew is cleaning basins, milling and paving on Lakeview Terrace and WVSA comes out once a month to clean out basins. Michelle asked WVSA for storm basin repair and she will check on them when they come out. They are working with PennDOT for permission to work on the state road.

Finance: Tom Kehler gave the report

Zoning: Bill Hilburt gave zoning report. Special Event Permit for a charity bike ride (Habitat for Humanity) that starts and ends at Penn State Lehman and goes through Harveys Lake.

A motion to accept the reports was made by Michell'e Boice and seconded by Chad Flack. Motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Motion to renew Police Pension program. Municipal Retirement System set up by the state. Chad Flack made a motion to renew it and Michell'e seconded. The motion carried.

The Back Mountain Community Partnership – They would like us to go in on a portable Speed minder. Danny Blaine made a motion to go ahead with the agreement and Michelle Boice seconded it. The motion passed.
