People from all walks of life can and do fall into these categories from time to time. It could happen to any of us.

Testimonial from a Haven Resident

I have been at the Haven of Mercy for the last 5 months. I came to the Haven for shelter after losing everything and living on the streets for almost a year. I was physically beaten and abused. I was offered free meth on the streets and became hooked on a "fix" two times a day. Then I got thrown in jail. After I got out of jail, I went back on the streets where I was beaten and used for sex. I was sleeping by the river, and in old abandoned buildings. Sometimes I caught a free meal at Salvation Army till they stopped serving meals. I had no friends, no family, just other users.

Finally, in desperation, I came to Haven of Mercy. I got a hot shower, a clean bed and three meals a day. I started helping in their thrift store. I attended chapel services and learned that God loved me, and that He had never given up on me. It's one thing to hear it, but here I learned I had to believe it and receive it for myself.

There was one special chapel service that really touched me. The pastor was anointing everyone in chapel with oil and praying over each person in there. When it was my turn and the pastor was praying over me, I felt an overwhelming warmth and peace and strength come into me. I asked the pastor if I could be forgiven for everything bad I'd done, and he said yes! He led me in a prayer for forgiveness, and asked Jesus to come into my heart and be my Savior and Lord. In the prayer, the pastor spoke to healing and for me to be delivered from brokenness and addictions. Something awesome changed in me that day. Since then, I've been free, yes, really free! No more desire or need for drugs. Jesus really set me free! I tell everybody I come across about it. Some believe it, but most don't. But I know I was saved that day, healed and delivered. And I know the Lord loves me! Im so thankful I came to the Haven of Mercy that first day!
