





Ti a chi

*There are two ways of saying 'you' in Welsh - **ti** and **chi**.*



Chi is used when you speak to:

- *a group of people (plural)*
- *someone you don't know / a stranger*
- *an older friend*
- *someone to whom you want to show respect,
e.g. a bank manager!*



Ti is used when you speak to:

- *a friend / someone with whom you
are very familiar*
- *someone of the same age*
- *a child*
- *a partner/husband/wife*
- *a pet*

Note: Ti is never used when you speak to a group of people, you must use chi.

There are some anomalies - e.g. some children are taught to use chi when speaking to one of their parents; lifelong friends of the same age might call each other chi, and some partners call each other chi.

If in doubt, use chi first: the other person may tell you to change to ti.

Gramadeg

Mae hi'n braf /niwlog etc. - 'hi' can be, and is often, left out, so listen out for Mae'n braf, Mae'n niwlog as well.

Mae hi'n ddiflas Describing words (adjectives) mutate (Treiglad Meddal) after yn.

We have come across one before: Mae e'n ddi-waith

so cymylog > Mae hi'n gymylog
gwell > Mae hi'n _well

Mae hi'n bwrw glaw

Doing words (verbs) stay as they are after yn as we've seen before: Mae e'n gweithio.

Braf never mutates - think of the Costa Brava, which is always sunny!



Dau and **dwy** are followed by a soft
mutation (treiglad meddal):

dau fab, dau gar
dwy ferch, dwy gath

It might be handy to have **more than two**
of everything to avoid the mutation, although
your partner/husband/wife might be surprised
to hear that you have more children than
he/she knew about!






