Operations update	- Registration: Registration is live and we sent our first email to all previous players. We have 38 signed up players so far for fall (as of June 5) and about 9 have paid so far. We will continue to promote each week to get players to sign up by July 1 and pay by July 1. We can take players up until the start of practice, but July 1 should be a goal.	
	- Practice Field Update: The school is just now starting rentals for 2025/2026 and we were informed that they are asking outside groups to start at 6pm when using school grounds. I asked for an explanation as to why? and will share when I get it this week. In the meantime, We may have to push practice at school back to 6-7pm with a 545 set up time. I am going to book fields from 6-730pm but it will get dark early come Oct - so we will have to see what is going on. More to come. Discussion at meeting - consider using funds for more turf time?	Chris has access to the turf schedule and will see what we might be able to swing after 7pm or a night when there is an away football game
	- Hosting: We are not hosting in 2025 - as the turf field schedule isn't done yet for the school and CV was able to get fields for that first week in Sept. We will look to host in 2026, but we can start to look for some Wed games to play some teams for 5/6 and 3/4 to add to the schedule. Anyone against me asking CV, Hempfield, Penn Manor to play

Discussion at meeting of "breakeven" in 2024 for field costs and revenue from concessions; not hosting shouldn't really impact budget in 2025	
2025 Budget	 Budget questions for 2025: Below is the budget for 2025. You will see that I am projecting 70 paying members at \$117 (that is what we keep after venmo fees from the \$120). I know we will have another 10-12 girls that play for free because they are coach kids or board kids. So we should make 8100 in revenues. Expenses should match perfectly with the budget below. You will see without us hosting we actually save the expense of the fields and it makes our budget line up well. A few things to note: Purchase 3/4 and 5/6 masks for league - We will need to spend about \$500 for masks for corners for 3/4 and 5/6 this year - everyone ok to add that to the budget? YES ¾ needs a new chest protector Plan for 3/4 and 5/6 officials costs - Expect officials fees to go up for 5/6 and we are going to try and get 3/4 officials for \$20 a game - so I added that in the budget Any issues with me shopping our insurance between American Specialties and Players Health - must renew in June? Approval to get pinnies going - Everyone ok if I start to get our yearly Pinnie going with the screen printer? I will share designs for this year Coaches Training and Membership - Can we agree to pay for a USAFH membership for all coaches - this way they get a background check, abuse prevention and membership. It is \$100 a coach, but worth the safety coverage and training options NOT YET
