Introduction

Dear Friend in Christ, we are delighted that you will join us in prayer for spiritual revival and national renewal. Our nation is in need of both. Jesus declared that His followers are the salt of the earth and the light of the world (Matthew 5:13-16). We must become engaged in this battle for our nation's soul. However, until as Christians we experience revival in our own lives, it will be extremely difficult to restore our nation's moral foundations.

The battle for our nation's soul is not just about voting booths. This is first and foremost a spiritual contest. A spiritual battle is being waged across our nation, and it must be met first of all with spiritual weapons. God's people must pray for a great outpouring of God's Spirit on them, the churches, and the nation. Then, when God has responded with His outpouring, His people will be empowered and motivated to do the hard work of restoring our nation's moral foundation.

This Prayer Guide will help you join with thousands of other fellow believers to bring these great needs before God. The Guide provides a page for each day and hour of the 40/40 Prayer Vigil. Each page has everything you need to invest in a time of personal spiritual reflection and petition for yourself, the church, and the nation. Please keep in mind though, that the Guide is just that — a guide. It is designed to give you a starting place for your time of prayer. Here are some suggestions for making your prayer vigil a powerful, personal spiritual time.

How to Get Started

This prayer guide can be used by an individual, a small group, an entire church body, or an even larger group. Here's how:

- First, decide if you want to use this as a personal guide to 40 days of prayer or ask others to join you.
- Second, decide if you want to pray for forty days or forty hours. The Guide is designed to support either of these options.
 - You can pray once each day between September 26 and November 4, for forty days of prayer.
 - You can pray for forty hours, between 4:00 p.m. on November 2 and 8:00 a.m. on November 4.
- Third, if you decide to make this a group effort, create a sign-up list and ask others to join you in the prayer time.
- Fourth, register your commitment to pray at the 40/40 Prayer Vigil Web site (4040prayer.com) to let others know that you are joining the national movement to seek God for spiritual revival and national renewal.

How to Use the Prayer Guide

STAY FOCUSED ON THE THEME FOR EACH PRAYER SESSION—For many of us, it is easy to get distracted during prayer. Many other prayer needs will probably come to mind as well. Unless God urges you to stop everything else and pray for these other concerns, consider writing them down and commit to pray for them when you have finished your current session.

MEDITATE ON THE BIBLE PASSAGES ON THE PAGE—Let the Holy Spirit speak to you through them and show you how they address your life, the church, and the nation.

PREPARE YOUR HEART FOR INTERCESSION—Let the Holy Spirit draw you into God’s presence and respond to Him as He speaks to you. Open your heart and your life to Him before you begin your time of intercession. Enjoy the closeness of His presence and fellowship.

USE THE SEVEN PRAYER POINTS AS STARTING POINTS—The prayer points provide areas of concern you can focus on, but they are not comprehensive. As you bring these concerns before the Lord, let the Holy Spirit guide you into other related areas that need your prayer. And always consider how to personalize your prayer. Consider praying for specific family members and friends, for your church, for your pastor and staff by name, for candidates by name, and so on.

CONCLUDE WITH THANKSGIVING—God hears the prayers of His people and responds. While He always acts according to His will, He has told us already it is His will to restore His blessing on the land of a people who meet His requirements for blessing. It is right to thank God for hearing you and working to glorify Himself through your prayers.

Thank you for entering into this Prayer Vigil with us. We look forward to watching what God does as His people meet His conditions for spiritual revival and national renewal. We pray God will do a great work in and through each of our lives as we meet with Him in prayer.

- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Give you a deeper longing to walk with Him
- Reveal Himself to you
- Help you put your relationship with Him before all things
- Remind you of His great love for you
- Draw you close to Himself
- Refresh your spirit
- Renew your spiritual joy

Thanksgiving

- Thank God for hearing you
- Trust that God is at work to accomplish His will



Prayer for Personal Revival

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Psalm 119:36-40

“36 Turn my heart to Your decrees and not to material gain. 37 Turn my eyes From looking at what is worthless; give me liFe in Your ways. 38 ConFirm what You said to Your servant, For it produces reverence For You. 39 Turn away the disgrace I dread; indeed, Your judgments are good. 40 How I long For Your precepts! Give me liFe through Your righteousness.”

Jeremiah 15:16

“16 Your words were Found, and I ate them. Your words became a delight to me and the joy of my heart, for I am called by Your name, Lord God of Hosts.”

Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Give you a deep thirst for His Word
- Reveal Himself to you as you read His Word
- Reveal the beauty of His Word to you
- Help you apply the truths in His Word to your life
- Show you areas of your life that need to be surrendered to Him
- Help you realize the depth of His love as you read His Word
- Help you trust Him more as you learn more about Him from His Word

Thanksgiving

- Thank God for hearing you
- Trust that God is at work to accomplish His will

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Psalm 51:10-12

“10 God, create a clean heart for me and renew a steadfast spirit within me. 11 Do not banish me from Your presence or take Your Holy Spirit from me. 12 Restore the joy of Your salvation to me, and give me a willing spirit.”

Philippians 1:9-11

“9 And I pray this: that your love will keep on growing in knowledge and every kind of discernment, 10 so that you can determine what really matters and can be pure and blameless in the day of Christ, 11 filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.”

2 Corinthians 13:5

Self-Examination

- Restore any lost joy in your walk with Him

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Ephesians 4:25-27

“25 Since you put away lying, Speak the truth, each one to his neighbor, because we are members of one another. 26 Be angry and do not sin. Don’t let the sun go down on your anger, 27 and don’t give the Devil an opportunity.”

John 13:34-35

“34 I give you a new commandment: love one another. Just as I have loved you, you must also love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

Colossians 3:12-15

“12 Therefore, God’s chosen ones, holy and loved, put on heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, 13 accepting one another and Forgiving one another if anyone has a complaint against another. - Help you know if you have contributed to broken relationships
- Help you determine to do all you can to mend broken relationships
- Help those you have hurt to forgive you
- Restore your fellowship with them
- Give you the courage to seek to restore fellowship
- Help you be a peacemaker whenever possible

- Thank God for hearing you
- Trust that God is at work to accomplish His will

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Isaiah 55:10-11

“**10** For just as rain and snow Fall From heaven, and do not return there without saturating the earth, and making it germinate and sprout, and providing seed to sow and Food to eat, **11** so My word that comes From My mouth will not return to Me empty, but it will accomplish what I please, and will prosper in what I send it to do.”

Luke 10:2

“**2** He told them: ‘The harvest is abundant, but the workers are few. Therefore, pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest!’”

Matthew 28:18-20

“**18** Then Jesus came near and said to them, ‘All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. **19** Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. Concern for the Lost

Christians should be genuinely, deeply burdened for lost souls.

Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Help you understand more about the plight of the lost
- Help you understand better how much He abhors sin
- Give you a greater understanding of His holiness
- Give you a renewed burden for the lost
- Help you share His message of love with the lost
- Save the lost people you will pray for right now
- Lead you to more lost people to witness to

Thanksgiving

- Thank God for hearing you
- Trust that God is at work to accomplish His will

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

1 John 1:9

“9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

Mark 1:15

“15 ‘The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe in the good news!’”

Luke 13:1-5

“1 At that time, some people came and reported to Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their sacrifices. 2 And He responded to them, ‘Do you think that these Galileans were more sinful than all Galileans because they suffered these things? 3 No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish as well! 4 Or those 18 that the tower in Siloam fell on and killed—do you think they were more sinful than all the people who live in Jerusalem? 5 No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish as well!’”

Repentance

Revival begins when Christians repent of their sin and embrace holiness.

Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Help you surrender every area of your life to Christ’s lordship
- Help you be aware of any sin in your life
- Help you be willing to give up sin in your life
- Help you change any patterns in your life that tempt you to sin
- Help you make strong Christian friendships that encourage you in holiness
- Help you live faithfully
- Help you to be an example of holiness to others

Thanksgiving

- Thank God for hearing you
- Trust that God is at work to accomplish His will



Prayer for Personal Revival

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Matthew 5:13-16

13 'You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt should lose its taste, how can it be made salty? It's no longer good for anything but to be thrown out and trampled on by men. **14** You are the light of the world. A city situated on a hill cannot be hidden.

15 No one lights a lamp and puts it under a basket, but rather on a lampstand, and it gives light for all who are in the house. **16** In the same way, let your light shine before men, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.'"

1 Timothy 2:1-4

1 First of all, then, I urge that petitions, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for everyone, **2** for kings and all those who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. **3** This is good, and it pleases God our Savior, **4** who wants everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

- Give your church a desire to reach your community for Christ
- Enable you to engage with the culture creatively and effectively
- Help you vote for good leaders who will respect and protect religious liberty
- Compel Christians to register and prepare to vote
- Help churches find creative ways to encourage Christians to register and prepare to vote

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

2 Corinthians 13:9

“9 In fact, we rejoice when we are weak and you are strong. We also pray for this: your maturity.”

Ephesians 3:17b-19

“17b I pray that you, being rooted and firmly established in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and width, height and depth, 19 and to know the Messiah’s love that surpasses knowledge, so you may be filled with all the fullness of God.”

Ezekiel 37:4-6

“4 He said to me, ‘Prophesy concerning these bones and say to them: Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! 5 This is what the Lord God says to these bones: I will cause breath to enter you, and you will live. 6 I will put tendons on you, make flesh grow on you, and cover you with skin. - Strengthen your church family’s burden for holiness
- Increase joy in your fellowship
- Strengthen your church’s commitment to its mission
- Raise up more laborers for ministry

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Philippians 1:9-11

“9 And I pray this: that your love will keep on growing in knowledge and every kind of discernment, 10 so that you can determine what really matters and can be pure and blameless in the day of Christ, 11 Filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.”

2 Corinthians 13:7-9

“7 Now we pray to God that you do nothing wrong, not that we may appear to pass the test, but that you may do what is right, even though we may appear to fail. 8 For we are not able to do anything against the truth, but only for the truth. 9 In fact, we rejoice when we are weak and you are strong. - Convict every person in each church of their unconfessed sin
- Fill the pastor of every church in the city with His Spirit
- Break down barriers that prevent churches from working together for the Gospel
- Reveal to each church anything that is hindering a great movement of God in their midst

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Philemon 1:6

“6 I pray that your participation in the Faith may become effective through knowing every good thing that is in us For the glory of Christ.”

“13 For you are called to Freedom, brothers; only don't use this Freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but serve one another through love. 22 But the Fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, Faith, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.”

Hebrews 12:14

“14 Pursue peace with everyone, and holiness—without it no one will see the Lord.”

Churches in Your State

Spirit-empowered churches across a state can change the state and influence the nation.

Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Pour out His Spirit on all the churches in your state
- Convict every Christian in the state about sin in their lives that hinders revival
- Give Christian leaders across the state a vision of what God wants to do through their church
- Remove any barriers to revival in the churches across the state
- Raise up men and women in the churches across the state to call the people to holiness
- Bind Satan and every demon and prevent them from interfering with revival
- Cause the Christians across your state to long for a close relationship with Him
