

Plymouth County 4-H Advisory Council The Duxbury-Marshfield 4-H Scholarship Application

Each year based on applicants and funding a minimum \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to student(s) who best meet the selection criteria and eligibility requirements as outlined below. This scholarship is funded by a gift from the Duxbury-Marshfield 4-H Town Council. The scholarship will be awarded by application each year. The scholarship will be awarded only one time to an individual. However, applicants may apply for this scholarship more than once.

ELIGIBILITY: Candidates must be:

- Must be a resident of Duxbury or Marshfield- proof of residency required.
- Must be pursing post-secondary education.
- > Applications must be received by April 1 at the Plymouth County 4-H Office.
- Applications will be notified of their award by June 1.
 - Awards will be payable to the applicant when proof of completion of the first semester and enrollment in the second semester of an educational institution is presented to the Plymouth County 4-H Advisory Council c/o Plymouth County 4-H Extension Office. Tuition payment receipt or other official document issued by the education institution will be acceptable proof.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Academic Standing, include transcript
- Interests including personal, academic, and career goals as well as involvement in extracurricular activities including community and volunteer activities.
- 2 Letters of recommendation teacher, employer, or a community leader.

APPLICATIONS:

Applications are due in the 4-H Extension office by April 1st
Applications which do not meet the requirements or are not received by April 1st (postmark will be taken into consideration) will be disregarded.
