POLICY REGARDING LISTS OF NASS-APPROVED STALLIONS

Approved NASS BOD 10-28-2021

"NASS will maintain lists of NASS-Approved Stallions to be used by the registry and Breeding Committee for registry and informational purposes and the lists will be posted on the NASS website.

The Breeding Committee Chairman is responsible for keeping the lists up to date and for reporting any changes in status on any stallion as they occur. The Breeding Committee Chairman, with the advice and consent of the Breeding Committee, will inform the Registrar, the Assistant Registrar, NASS Officers, the Board of Directors and the Webmaster of such changes in a timely manner.

1) "Active Approved Stallions"--All NASS-approved stallions standing in the United States and Canada whose owners are active members in good standing of NASS as required by the Registry. For additional information on each stallion, contact the owner from the contact information provided.

List will be alphabetical and will include the following;

- 1) Registered Name, Registration number, year of birth and color, followed by current status (i.e. alive, dead, gelded)
- 2) Pedigree: Sire, dam, damsire {example: (Bobby x Martha by George)}, followed by either "SCID/CA Genetic Test on File" or "SCID/CA Genetic Test not Submitted"
- 3) Book and Book Number followed by Performance Test Information for every stallion, to include all of the following information:
 - a) year completed
 - b) discipline or test (i.e. "dressage", 70 day test,")
- c) if no performance test achieved but approved prior to performance test being required. this should be stated.
 - d) if excused from performance test due to injury this should be stated
- 4) Breeding method available, i.e. live cover, cooled semen, frozen semen
- 5) Two photos allowed, preferably one halter photo and one other
- 6) Stallion Owner contact information and Lessor if relevant, to include name, farm name, e-mail, address, phone, website

2) "Inactive Approved Stallions"-- All NASS-approved stallions that are unavailable for breeding mares in North America (i.e. stallions now deceased, gelded, retired from breeding, or whose semen is not longer available for any reason) whose owners were NASS members in good standing as required by the Registry at the time when the stallions were actively breeding mares in North America.

List will include the following;

- 1) Registered Name, Registration number, year of birth and color, followed by current status (i.e. alive but retired, dead, gelded)
- 2) Pedigree: Sire, dam, damsire {example: (Bobby x Martha by George)}, followed by either "SCID/CA Genetic Test on File" or "SCID/CA Genetic Test not Submitted"
- 3) Book and Book Number followed by Performance Test Information for every stallion, to include all of the following information:
 - a) year completed
 - b) discipline or test (i.e. "dressage", 70 day test,")
- c) if no performance test achieved but approved prior to performance test being required. this should be stated.
 - d) if excused from performance test due to injury this should be stated
- 4) Two photos allowed, preferably one halter photo and one other
- 3) "Approved Stallions Whose Owners Are Not NASS Members In Good Standing" as required by the Registry--Offspring of stallions whose owners are not NASS members in "good standing" with the registry are not eligible for registration with NASS until such time as the registry requirements are met.

Each owner of the offspring of a stallion whose owner is not a NASS member in good standing during the year of registration and/or during the year of conception may register such an offspring by paying a "stallion activation surcharge", provided that all the other registration requirements in the Guidelines are fulfilled.

If the stallion owner is not a NASS member in good standing due to nonpayment of membership fees during the year of conception and/or the year of offspring registration, , the surcharge will be in the amount of the active membership fee which the stallion owner did not pay during the year of conception and also did not pay during the year of registration. This requirement will apply to register each offspring of said stallion.
