Bravo Awards Committee

The Bravo Award Committee shall concentrate on the development of recognition for any activity not recognized by the traditional NASS Performance Awards.

- 1) The award itself will be named "The Bravo Award."
- 2) The award can be given by nomination to any person or Shagya-Arabian-bred horse for any activity designated by the committee and approved by the NASS BOD. This could include, but not limited to, performance in competition in any horse-connected discipline, any notable achievement in horsemanship utilizing Shagya-Arabian horses, any humanitarian act utilizing Shagya-Arabian-bred horses, any breeding or horse management achievement involving Shagya-Arabian horses, any accomplishment or recognition involving Shagya-Arabian promotion locally, regionally, or internationally.

The Bravo Award Guidelines

The Bravo Award will be awarded up to three times per year and to run with the publication of the NASS Newsletter in order to publicize the honored recipient.

The Awards will be considered by nominations. Any NASS member can nominate another member or their NASS Registered Shagya-Arabian, Part Shagya-Arabian, or Part Shagya for any accomplishment.

Nominations can be made at any time. Awards may be awarded up to three times per year. Announcements will be made as Awards are presented. If no nominations are made during a year, previous years nominations can be considered for the Award. All nominations made in previous years can be considered for current year Award. The nomination does not have to be for a current event.

Bravo Awards will be shared on the NASS website and an article will be published in the NASS Newsletter.

Awards will be a Certificate of Recognition and any small tokens that NASS may have available, ie, t-shirt, hat, key chain, if available.

Nominations shall be submitted to the Bravo Award Committee by letter form with full explanation of their nomination for review of the Bravo Award Committee and presentation to the Board of Directors.
