### RULES

- 1. NEW RULE!! CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE REQUIRES ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS TO COMPLETE THE YOUTH QUALITY ASSURANCE CERTIFICATION PROGRAM. THIS IS A WEB BASED PROGRAM EACH EXHIBITOR CAN DO AT HOME. VISIT [KINGSFAIR.COM](http://KINGSFAIR.COM) TO USE THE LINK TO REGISTER AND COMPLETE CERTIFICATION. PROOF OF COMPLETION WILL BE REQUIRED WITH ENTRY SUBMISSION.**
2. Make entry on Poultry Entry Form **ONLINE ONLY!**
3. American System of Judging applies. This is a non-sanctioned show.
4. Definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Official Show Rules and Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Association, Inc. shall apply to all district and county fair poultry shows, except in such instances where they are in conflict with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
5. **All birds must be brought to gate A for inspection. No birds will be allowed onto the fairgrounds if they do not pass inspection.** All entrants will be given documentation showing that the bird passed inspection. This document must be shown to a poultry official at the barn before check-in. **No birds will be allowed onto the fairgrounds unless they have been entered in the fair.**
6. Birds will be shown and judged in the proper division and class for breed, variety and sex only. If no class is offered, no awards may be made. Disqualified birds and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.

7. A judge may excuse a bird from competition if it appears to be fatigued or out of condition, but the bird shall be counted as an entry. All Birds will be inspected by a licensed state inspector. If bird is sent home there are NO REFUNDS. No sick birds will be cooped. EXAMINE YOUR BIRDS CAREFULLY BEFORE ARRIVAL FOR CHECK IN.
8. Only birds owned and exhibited by the Exhibitor are eligible to be used in Showmanship Classes.
9. Exhibitors are required to wear the official uniform of the organization they represent.
10. ALL BIRDS MUST HAVE NUMBERED LEG BANDS. All classes of Poultry and other type of birds must be identified by leg bands conforming to the Entry Form upon arrival at the show.
10. Exhibitor is expected to feed, water and care for their birds. Market animals must have sufficient feed available to them at all times.
11. Exhibitor must provide **sufficient and appropriate feed**, in clearly labeled feed containers. Appropriate type and number of feeders for each of their exhibits. **No feeders or water containers will be provided.**
12. All exhibitors must sign up for barn duty. Sign up at the poultry barn at time of check-in. Sign up will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Number and length of shifts will be determined by the number of entrants. Exhibitors who do not sign up for barn duty or do not show up for their barn duty will be subject to a \$25.00 fine and or "red tagged".
13. Exhibitor MUST be a 4-H, Grange, FFA member, or Independent to enter showmanship.
14. **RED TAGGING** will occur if exhibitor's area and pens are not kept neat, food, water supplied and necessary clean bedding. There will be a refuse location for soiled bedding. Management will inspect barns on a daily basis and "RED TAG" pens found in unsanitary condition.
15. Any exhibitor receiving a second "RED TAG" will forfeit any awards earned. A third "RED TAG" will require exhibitor to remove the animal(s) from the grounds, forfeiture of awards and exhibitor's pass. If exhibitor has sold the animal the sale will be VOIDED.
16. Refer to State and Local Junior Department Rules for further information.
17. **The Kings Fair has established rules for show attire for all livestock exhibitors. Refer to individual exhibitor section for attire in the livestock department. No exhibitor will be allowed to show or exhibit wearing blue jeans, open toe shoes or tee shirts. All shirts/blouses must have a collar. Tank tops or sleeveless shirts are not allowed.** Please look in the Livestock Department for 4-H & FFA dress attire.
18. **Primary 4-H & Jr's (7 & 8 yrs) can Exhibit Only and Can Not Show or Sell.**
19. **No one under 7yrs can participate in the animal divisions.**
20. Exhibitor must enter showmanship bird in designated breed class.

**RULES**

1. Each participant must be a member of a Kings County 4-H Club, California Grange or FFA Poultry Project.
2. Chicks purchased from Evangelho Feed & Farm, Sanchez Feed & Seed or any authorized dealer must be purchased, no later than April 18, 2019. Proof of age, **(i.e. signed bill of sale or donation), must be attached to the entry form. They must be (chickens) 42-45 days old at the time of show.**
3. Pre ordered Turkeys. Dates of purchase between 12/25/18 and 2/12/19.
4. **They must be 15-22 weeks old at the time of show.**
5. **Proof of age, (i.e. signed bill of sale, receipt, or donation), must accompany bird at check in. No Exceptions.**
6. **Failure to provide proof of age with entry will result in disqualification of birds.**
7. A meat pen (chickens) consists of two chickens 42-45 days old and weighing 4-6 1/2 lbs. each.
8. **Turkey Pens-** one bird - Tom or Hen
9. **Exhibitor can only sell ONE SPECIE ANIMAL** at the Junior Livestock Auction. If the exhibitor has multiple market animals the exhibitor is to choose which animal to sell and notify the Poultry Superintendent and Livestock Office within half hour after the Market Animal has been judged.
10. Champion and Reserve Champion meat pens can sell at Junior Livestock Auction unless the exhibitor prefers to sell a market animal of another species.
11. Blue ribbon winners may sell at the Junior Livestock Auction if that is the only animal being sold at Saturday's Auction.
12. Sold meat pens may be donated back to exhibitor, but not resold in auction.
13. Both birds in a poultry meat pen should have the same number on both bands

3. Eggs must be submitted in an egg carton. An egg information Card must be filled out and turned in with eggs.
4. Only chicken eggs will be accepted (brown, white or colored).
5. All eggs shown must be chicken eggs selected by the exhibitor. Eggs from a grocery store are not allowed.
6. Eggs may be Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large or Jumbo. Small eggs are not less than 18 ounces per dozen. Medium eggs are not less than 21 ounces per dozen. Large eggs are not less than 24 ounces per dozen. Extra Large eggs are not less than 27 ounces per dozen. Jumbo eggs are not less than 30 ounces per dozen.
7. Eggs must be submitted at the time of check in, Tuesday May 28<sup>th</sup> between 8 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.
8. Eggs will be judged on interior as well as exterior quality, matching and uniformity
9. Eggs become the property of the Fair Association and will be disposed of after the fair.
