



Dear Junior Livestock & Replacement Dairy Exhibitors,

Thank you for your patience during these times! We have been working endlessly to get this accomplished for our exhibitors who are excited to get back in the show ring. I have attached the show schedule to this letter for your information and have also sent this to your leaders and advisors. Please contact them and ask them any questions you may have before calling our office. We are working with hundreds of exhibitors and buyers at this time and many questions can be explained and answered by your leaders and advisors. Thank you all for completing your online entries on time and making our process as smooth as can be. You will need to log back into ShoWorks to complete this next step! When you log into your ShoWorks account you will need to add an entry for your corresponding animal. This entry is FREE!! And will allow us to keep track of your photo uploads along the way without confusion. This photo will be used for the online auction on June 12th. If you have more than one animal entered the market show you will need to create an entry for each of these animals and include their Tag ID in that entry to assure, we scratch the correct lot after the show has completed and the exhibitor confirms which animal/lot they would like to sell during the virtual auction. If you have a market hog you will need to insert the Ear Notch in place of the Tag ID. Below you will find our guidelines and instructions for the picture. With time being crucial we want to remind everyone to read all the guidelines because there will not be a chance for “re-do’s” if what is submitted is not acceptable, appropriate or does not meet guidelines below, you will be notified, and that animal will not have a picture for the auction. We are following the guidelines and rules set in our show catalog which you can also find on our website if you have not printed it already (I highly recommend you do). All animals will be dropped off on June 13th to Overland Stock Yards and we will be sending all exhibitors a schedule and instructions for the drop off. To follow guidance from CDFA and state rules we will be limited to the amount of guest passes available for the day of the show, your leader or advisor has those limitations. All animals going through the Online Auction will be terminal. There will be no “live” pick up options except for Dairy Replacement and Yearling Heifers and Prospective Steer Projects. Exhibitors’ parents, leaders and advisors will need to coordinate to have animals dropped off during those species time slots. We will send out further details on drop off in the coming weeks. Finally, we would like to thank everyone for their patience, and we understand that many families have decided to keep their animals or sell them on their own! Please notify our office if you have decided to scratch your animal from our auction. If you have any questions, feel free to give our office a call.

Online Auction Guidelines and Instructions

1. All animals must be clean and presentable in pictures for the online auction. All Species ARE REQUIRED to be sheared/clipped.
2. All animals are being inspected on the day of show (schedule below) and this will include, weight, health, and judged. If your animal does not pass inspections, you will have to load that animal and take it back at that time and be scratched from the auction. Disciplinary action may be decided by the fair manager and fair board.
3. All weights listed in 2021 show catalog will apply and be enforced. **If you believe your animal will not pass inspection or weight, call our office and scratch it from the show and auction!**
4. YQCA certification is required and must be completed before you can enter your animal into the show.
5. A Declaration of Medication form must be filled out and signed prior to arriving to the fairgrounds for your show day. These forms will be available on our website and sent to your leaders.
6. A COVID-19 Release of Liability Waiver must be filled out and signed by a parent or guardian prior to arriving to the fairgrounds on show day. This form will also be available on our website and sent to your leaders.
7. You are only allowed to sell one specie in the online auction. If you have contracted one market animal and one dairy replacement/yearling heifer you may sell both.
8. **ALL ANIMALS MUST HAVE ALREADY TURNED A CONTRACT IN TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS AUCTION. We will be verifying entries with contracts.**
9. Ear tags will be distributed to the 4-H leaders and FFA advisors after the entry process closes. Your animal must be tagged with the tag provided by the fair on the right side of the animal (if standing behind animal) BEFORE you enter the fairgrounds on show day.
10. Market animal exhibitors will need to submit one picture of themselves with their animal. The picture must show the ENTIRE animal's right-side profile (if standing behind the animal) AND the exhibitor.
11. Dairy replacement and yearling heifer exhibitors will need to submit two pictures of themselves with their heifer. One picture must show the animal's entire right-side profile (if standing behind) with the exhibitor, and the second picture must show the entire back end of the heifer, including the udder, from the top of the tail to the hooves (udder shot).
12. ALL exhibitors (market animal and dairy replacement/yearling heifer exhibitors) MUST be in their organization's show attire in their photos. If the exhibitor is an Independent exhibitor, you must wear white pants, close-toed shoes, and a white shirt (ex: white button-down with collar, etc.). Any exhibitor who does not follow the dress code will not have a picture displayed for the auction.
13. When uploading documents please use exhibitors first and last names as file name. If you have two animals entered, please include the Tag ID or Ear Notch in the file name.
14. If the exhibitor's heifer calves after June 10th, the calf must be delivered with the cow (buyer gets calf).
15. All animals will be sold per head. The fair commission has been returned to 8% and is applied to the animal's sale price and add-on amounts.
16. Add-on forms, along with new buyer registration forms, are available on the Kings Fair website. Add-ons are due to the Kings Fair office by Wednesday, June 30th, 2021 by 4pm.
17. **IF THE EXHIBITOR CHOOSES TO NOT DELIVER THEIR ANIMAL TO OVERLAND STOCKYARDS ON JUNE 13TH WITHOUT NOTIFYING THE**

FAIR OFFICE BEFORE JUNE 10TH, THAT EXHIBITOR WILL NO LONGER BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE AT THE KINGS FAIR IN THE FUTURE (at the fair manager and fair board's discretion).

18. All 2021 Kings Fair show catalog rules and regulations, along with 2021 California state fair rules, apply.

(Subject to Change - Dependent upon number of Entries per Species)

1. MASKS, TEMPATURE CHECKS AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY WAIVERS WILL BE REQUIRED BEFORE ENTRANCE TO FAIRGROUNDS!
2. ALL TRAILERS MUST PARK IN THE HANFROD ARMONA LOT (OLD CVC PARKING LOT) BEFORE SHOWS WILL BEGIN.
3. ALL CAR PASSES WILL BE USED IN THE LIVESTOCK PARKING LOT AND USE THE HANFORD ARMONA LOT (OLD CVC PARKING LOT) FOR OVERFLOW.

MONDAY, JUNE 7TH

Poultry Check-In, Inspection and Weigh-in between 9 am – 10 am

Poultry Meat Pens and Showmanship Judging beginning promptly at 10:30 am

Load Out: once all judging is completed animals will be assigned a load out slot and will leave the fairgrounds.

Drop Off: All animals will be delivered to Overland Stock Yards on Sunday June 13th during their assigned drop off time. See Sunday's Schedule for drop off assignments.

TUESDAY, JUNE 8TH

Hog Check-In, Inspection and Weigh-in between 6 am – 8 am

Hog Show will begin at 11am! The show will start with Showmanship, followed by market class, followed by breeding classes.

Load Out: once all judging is completed animals will be assigned a load out slot and will leave the fairgrounds.

Drop Off: All animals will be delivered to Overland Stock Yards on Sunday June 13th during their assigned drop off time. See Sunday's Schedule for drop off assignments.

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 9TH

Sheep and Goat Check-In, Inspection and Weigh-in between 6 am – 8 am

Goat Show will begin at 11am! The show will start with Showmanship, followed by market class, followed by breeding classes.

Sheep Show will begin promptly following the goat shows completion! The show will start with Showmanship, followed by market class, followed by breeding classes.

Load Out: once all judging is completed animals will be assigned a load out slot and will leave the fairgrounds.

Drop Off: All animals will be delivered to Overland Stock Yards on Sunday June 13th during their assigned drop off time. See Sunday's Schedule for drop off assignments.

THURSDAY, JUNE 10TH

Beef Check-In, Inspection and Weigh-in between 6 am – 8 am
Dairy Check-In, Inspection and registration paper entry between 6 am – 8 am

Beef Show will begin at 11am! The show will start with Showmanship, followed by market class, followed by breeding classes.

Dairy Show will begin at 11am! The show will start with Showmanship, followed by replacement heifer and yearling classes, followed by breeding classes.

Load Out: once all judging is completed animals will be assigned a load out slot and will leave the fairgrounds.
Drop Off: All animals will be delivered to Overland Stock Yards on Sunday June 13th during their assigned drop off time. See Sunday's Schedule for drop off assignments.
