### RULES

1. Make entry on Poultry Entry Form for SHOWMANSHIP, UGLIEST CHICKEN CONTEST, POSTER CONTEST, ROOSTER CROWING CONTEST AND EGG SHOW **ONLINE ONLY!**
2. Paper entry forms available for Presentations, King's Poultry Trivia Team Challenge and Grading Eggs Contest.
3. American System of Judging applies. This is a non-sanctioned show.
4. Definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Official Show Rules and Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Association, Inc. shall apply to all district and county fair poultry shows, except in such instances where they are in conflict with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
5. Exhibitors are required to wear the official uniform of the organization they represent.
6. All exhibitors must sign up for barn duty. Sign up at the poultry barn at time of check-in. Sign up will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Number and length of shifts will be determined by the number of entrants.
7. Exhibitor **MUST** be a 4-H, Grange, FFA member, or Independent to enter showmanship.
8. **The Kings Fair has established rules for show attire for all livestock exhibitors. Refer to individual exhibitor section for attire in the livestock department. No exhibitor will be allowed to show or exhibit wearing blue jeans, open toe shoes or tee shirts. All shirts/blouses must have a collar. Tank tops or sleeveless shirts are not allowed. Please look in the Livestock Department for 4-H & FFA dress attire.**
9. **Primary 4-H & Jr's (7 & 8 yrs) can Exhibit Only and Can Not Show or Sell.**
10. **No one under 7yrs can participate in the animal divisions.**

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## POULTRY SHOWMANSHIP

Exhibitors are required to wear the official uniform of the organization they represent.

### RULES

1. Showmanship will be held behind the poultry barn in an area designated by the superintendent.
2. Showmanship is optional
3. FFA novice showmanship champion does not compete in Round Robin showmanship.
4. **Decisions of the judges are FINAL. Any interference of an adult could be disqualification of the exhibitor.**

### **DIVISION 930-EGG Show**

#### Class

1. All exhibitors must be entered in the Youth Poultry Show.
2. One dozen eggs per exhibitor may be submitted.
3. Eggs must be submitted in an egg carton. An egg information Card must be filled out and turned in with eggs.
4. Only chicken eggs will be accepted (brown, white or colored).
5. All eggs shown must be chicken eggs selected by the exhibitor. Eggs from a grocery store are not allowed.
6. Eggs may be Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large or Jumbo. Small eggs are not less than 18 ounces per dozen. Medium eggs are not less than 21 ounces per dozen. Large eggs are not less than 24 ounces per dozen. Extra Large eggs are not less than 27 ounces per dozen. Jumbo eggs are not less than 30 ounces per dozen.
7. Eggs must be submitted on Wednesday May 29<sup>th</sup> at 3:30 pm and 4 pm
8. Eggs will be judged on interior as well as exterior quality, matching and uniformity
9. Eggs become the property of the Fair Association and will be disposed of after the fair.

# KING'S POULTRY TRIVIA TEAM CHALLENGE

## Purpose of the Contest

1. To encourage youth to expand their knowledge of avian facts and become proficient in poultry management and related subjects.
2. To promote the poultry industry by stimulating their interest in poultry and other avian species.
3. To make learning Fun!

## Rules and Information:

1. All participants must be entered in the KING'S POULTRY TRIVIA TEAM CHALLENGE. All entrants will be emailed a study guide.
2. All participants will be divided into 2 teams. Team members will appoint a team captain.
3. Officials:
  - a. **MODERATOR**- Assumes complete direction of the contest, asks all questions, designates contestants to answer questions, and rules on the acceptability of any answer. Is at all times **IN CHARGE**.
  - b. **Time Keeper**- Indicates to the moderator the expiration of the time allowed in which to answer questions.
  - c. **Score Keeper**- Score should be kept visible to the moderator, contestants and audience
4. The audience is required at all time to refrain from providing answers to any team member. Disciplinary action for violations will be at the discretion of the contest judge.
5. The degree of difficulty and choice of questions will depend upon the contestants' level of knowledge.
6. Questions may be presented orally or visually, such as in the form of written words or photographs.
7. The moderator will ask a question. The first person to raise their hand must start to answer the question within five (5) seconds after being acknowledged or lose 5 points. Timing begins as soon as you are acknowledged.
8. Any member answering without being acknowledged loses 5 points
9. Incorrect answers lose 5 points
10. After an incorrect or non-answer the opposing team will have to opportunity to answer within five (5) seconds, but the question will NOT be repeated.
11. If a hand is raised before the question is completely read, the moderator shall stop reading the question, and the contestant has five (5) seconds to answer based on that portion of the question and the judge may NOT ask for any further information.
12. If the interrupted question is answered incorrectly, the question shall then be re-read and the other team will have the opportunity to answer it.
13. If a question is asked and neither team offers an answer within 10 seconds, the moderator will give the answer, and no points will be awarded or forfeited.
14. The ONLY discussion allowed between team members will be on bonus questions. The answer must be given by the team captain. Teams will be given ten (10) seconds to consult, and then the captain must start to answer within five (5) seconds after time is called. The captain will be given 30 seconds to complete the answer required.

15. Only the number of answers required by the bonus question will be accepted. Example: If the bonus question has a four part answer, the first four answers given by the team captain will be accepted.
16. There are 3 types of questions-
  - a. Regular Questions- 5 pts
  - b. Bonus Questions- 10 pts-  
After each person answers a regular question correctly a colored card in front of the member will be turned over by the moderator. Once all the team members have their cards turned over that team will be asked a bonus question. If the team answers incorrectly the opposing team will then be allowed to answer the questions. A bonus question can have multiple parts.
  - c. Tie-Breaker Questions-5 pts- In the event of a tie, 5 additional questions will be asked; first team to raise the hands will have the first chance to answer.
17. Answers and interpretations of questions will be the sole responsibly and final recall of the judge. All decisions of the judges, time keepers and scorekeepers are **FINAL**
