

**Minutes**  
**Ida Township Board Meeting**  
**July 1, 2019**  
**Ida Township Hall**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Dan Diedrich. Supervisor Jim Peterson and Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Kilgore were also present. Supervisor Mike Steidl was absent. The pledge of allegiance was conducted.

Diedrich announced that the recorder being used to record the meeting belongs to the clerk and is only used to assist her in taking the minutes of the meeting.

### **Minutes**

**June 17, 2019 Town Board Meeting.** Diedrich made the motion to approve the minutes of the June 17, 2019 Town Board Meeting as written. Peterson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Diedrich-aye Peterson-aye.

### **Roads**

**Road Report.** Diedrich reported that the gravel ordered on the Road Review has been put on the roads. A few other soft spots may show up and require more gravel.

- **West Side Improvement Phase 2.**
  - **Phase 2 update.** Blaine Green (WSN) reported that Riley Brothers will be blading and shaping the Water Lily Trail area roads on Wednesday, July 3, 2019. Blacktop is expected to be put down the week of July 8, 2019.
  - **Phase 1 update.** Blaine Green (WSN) informed the Board that CSI has finished the work on the manhole covers and will be submitting the invoice for final payment.
  - **Shady Haven Drive.** Greg Nolan said that he has a concrete apron at the end of his driveway on Shady Haven Drive that he would like to keep in place. Blaine Green (WSN) that they will join the driveway to the new blacktop as best they can.
- **Wahtomin Shores Speed Bumps.** Blaine Green (WSN) said that the City of Alexandria Street Department has rubber speed bumps available to borrow. Diedrich will have RBS contact them and pick up and put the speed bumps in place at Wahtomin Shores.
- **Chloride.** Diedrich stated that Chloride should be completed on July 2, 2019. We used approximately 15,000 gallons.
- **Right-of-Way issues.** Diedrich went and checked on a retaining wall that was installed on Betsy Ross Road. The retaining wall is in the township right-of-way, but Diedrich doesn't think it will be a problem for snow removal.

### **Old Business**

**Signature Documents for 8038-G for the 2019A Bond.** Diedrich and Kilgore signed the needed documents for the 8038-G Information Return for Tax-Exempt Governmental Obligation Bonds.

**New Business**

**Town Hall Ceiling.** Kilgore informed the Board that there are two spots in the Town Hall ceiling that are leaking. The Board instructed her to call the Township Insurance Company and to get an estimate from Master Builders on the cost to fix it.

**Mail and Permits.** The mail and permits were reviewed by the Supervisors.

**Public Comment**

**Cheryl Arnold** commented that the Board needs to be consistent on how they treat property owners with items in the township road right-of-way.

**Adjourn.** Diedrich made the motion to adjourn at 8:00 p.m. Peterson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Diedrich-aye, Peterson-aye.
