

Minutes
Ida Township Road Review Meeting
April 25, 2026
Ida Township Hall
4700 County Rd 6 NW, Garfield, MN 56332

The Board of Supervisors and Clerk/Treasurer Heather Miller proceeded from the Township Hall at 8:00 a.m. on April 25, 2026, to check the condition of the roads of the township.

Issues noted on the review:

- **Tree Trimming/Removal**
 - 81st Avenue – Tree trimming needed near Co Rd 6 Brush Trimming needed.
 - Utopia (South End) – Overhang will need to be cleaned up.
 - Bedman – Tree trimming will need to be done on the North side.
 - Big Horn Bay - Tree trimming needed, also contact DNR about trimming trees on North Side.
 - Blue Jay Way – RBS will remove trees – removal up to the fence. Resident notified. Tree Trimming is needed as well.
 - Buckskin Lane – Tree on curve needs to be removed.
 - Clear View Road – Tree removal on the east side.
 - Mallard Lane – Tree Trimming
 - Maple Circle – Tree in ditch to be removed.
 - Memory Lane – (9256) Brush to be cleared near the road.
 - Pleasant Grove – Tree removed on south side of road.
 - Primrose Lane – Remove tree growing into culvert.
 - Sugar Sand – Trees in ditch removed and brush trimmed.
 - Sunset Strip – Tree trimming along Lake Charley.
 - Tasha Drive
- **Culverts**
 - Betsy Ross/Little Ida – This Culvert will need to be replaced in the near future.
- **Shouldering**
 - Betsy Ross – Shouldering needed on inside corner.
 - Breezy Circle
 - Gehrkes Point – Shouldering on the turn around.
 - Kaycee Lane – Shouldering on inside curb.
 - Leaf Lane – Shouldering inside corner
 - Little Ida Beach Road
 - Memory Lane – Shoulder at bottom of road/hill washed out next to waterlily.
 - Oakwood Terrace – Widen south corner
 - Sunny Brook Drive
 - Talon Road
 - Tasha Drive
- **Crack Sealing**
 - Nothing to report at this time

- **Signs**
 - Clear View Road NW
 - Breezy/Wahtomin
 - Rolling Acres – sign needs to be put back up.
- **Other**
 - Aldrich Road – Gravel in the ditch needs to be clean out.
 - Bedman Drive (south side) – Talk with Jeff Stabnow about a feasibility study for the road.
 - Betsy Ross -Rocks near road (3639) need to be removed – letter sent to homeowner.
 - Cottontail Lane – Hole in gravel near stop sign needs to be fixed.
 - Maple Circle – Wood pile to be removed (9337) – letter sent to homeowner.

Gravel

1 Load = 1 belly dump truck (\$17/ yard)

Gravel for the 2026 season will be determined by Diedrich and RBS and applied as needed. The township has contracted 4000 yards of gravel with RBS.

Chloride

Will be put down as it was in 2025 per the Chloride Map from 2025.

Spray

The township will have ditches sprayed as noted in the attached map marked 2026 spray.

The board returned to the township hall at 12:00 p.m. and the meeting was adjourned.
