In 1994, the federal Early Head Start program was created to give all young children the same opportunities to succeed. Young children living in poverty are more likely to face challenges that negatively impact their development.

Research shows that Early Head Start improves a child’s success in school, leads to greater family self-sufficiency and encourages parents to support their child’s development.

Triumph, Inc. has two options for families birth through age 3. Our Early Head Start Home Based Program is for families who’s children may stay home to receive services from a home visitor and participate in socialization groups. Our EHS Center Based program is for children who come to our center and receive care from qualified teachers between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
