

## **Important Information for Families!**

- No changes to schedules for Early Head Start Center Based Families
- Fay's Place will remained closed until further notice
- Full Day children (voucher, DCF, etc...) can attend 5 days per week 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with a maximum of 10 children per classroom
- Head Start Center Based children will be placed in either hybrid model (2 days in school/2 days home) or fully remote
- You will receive a letter from our ERSEA team with your child's assigned option and classroom
- Hybrid classes will meet either Monday & Tuesday or Thursday and Friday (day off Wednesday)
  - \* Hybrid classes have a maximum of 15 children per classroom
  - \* Hours for hybrid classes are 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Fully remote option students will having learning at their own pace via Class Dojo or YouTube
  - \* Families must log on at a minimum of 3 times per week to remain enrolled
- Sept. 7th SCHOOL IS CLOSED for the Labor Day Holiday
- **Sept. 11th** last day at Triumph for students who will be going to kindergarten
- **Sept. 21st** new school year for Head Start (hybrid or fully remote)
- Sept. 28th transportation begins but VERY LIMITED this year. You will be notified if you are selected
- Nov. 27th end date for program options you are placed in September (hybrid or fully remote)

## FAQ:

Can full day families chose fully remote learning? There may be opportunities for full day children to be fully remote. We are checking into this and will inform families

What if a family doesn't have internet or technology (chromebook)? We are working with the Public Schools, community partners and grants to see if we can purchase additional items for our families

Will EEC continue to pay for the parent fees for our vouchers? We are checking with the State to get clarification about parent fees

Will there be a parent child orientation day? Yes, we are working on having a day for newly enrolled children and children who haven't been in school since March to visit their centers. This will be a day to have child health screenings completed, gather information on parent opportunities and important agency policies
