

ANTEDILUVIAN POPULATION PROJECTIONS GIVEN OF 18 & 20 CHILDREN/COUPLE FOR 10 GENERATIONS WITH TWO DISTINCT GENEALOGY'S (SEED OF THE SERPENT & THE SEED OF THE WOMAN)

Based on virility of older subjects, toxic-free environment, disease minimization, elevated atmospheric oxygen content, high nutritional-vitamin-mineral content of foods, minimal genetic degradation, the earth perpendicular to its orbital plane (as opposed to its current 23.5-degree tilt) accounting for equal daylight hours in the northern and southern latitudes, longevity evident especially among the sons of God, and one universal language, these numbers are thus revealed. 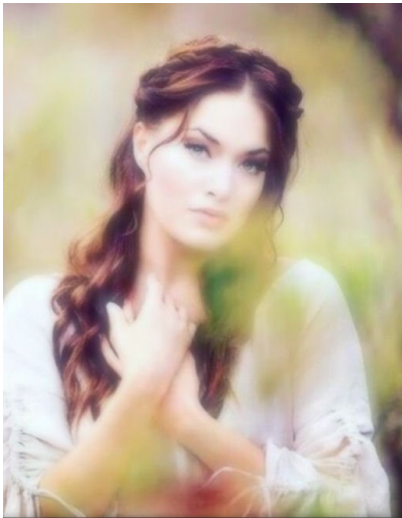

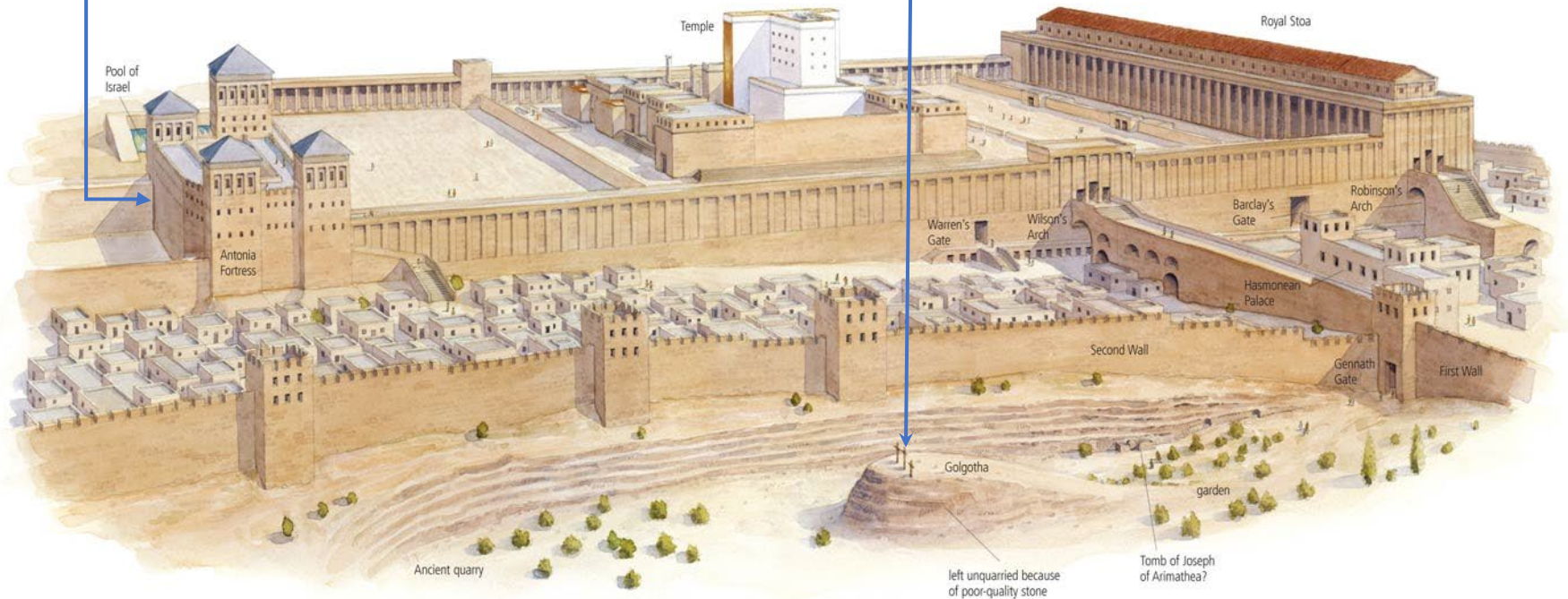
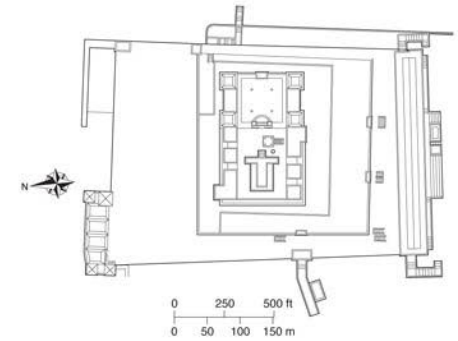
Dead Sea Rift Valley—“the nether parts of the earth.” Ezek. 31:16, 18

EDEN—Looking south and to the left is what is currently known as the Jordanian plateau or the land of Nod (Gen. 4:16). It is here that the Arnon River (Wadi Mujib) empties into the Dead Sea. Before the flood; however, this lowland valley was the home of Eden where every tree that was good for food and pleasant to the eyes grew AND the river coming out of Eden parted into four heads, namely a source for the headwaters of four notable rivers: Pison, Gihon, Hiddekel, and Euphrates. Two of these rivers, which ran parallel to each other, headed south and diverged where the present Gulf of Aqaba and the port of Eilat are located. The other two, Hiddekel and Euphrates, flowed north and eventually eastward in the northern area generally labeled as the Fertile Crescent. **The above labels indicate people groups that settled and inhabited the region sometime AFTER THE FLOOD.** The Bible is a story of men returning to their place of origin; whether that was the second Adam, namely Christ crucified at Calvary, where Adam was created from the dust of the ground OR Moses fleeing Egypt as a fugitive to Mt. A WORK OF ARK

The sixth and seventh chapters of the book of Genesis record the extraordinary account of the ark that God commanded Noah to build to escape the great flood that covered the earth. The flood destroyed all life but Noah's and "those who were with him in the ark." Genesis 7:23b

The ark was made of "gopher" wood. The vessel was then caulked with pitch. The passengers remained safe inside until the waters of the flood subsided, nearly one year later.

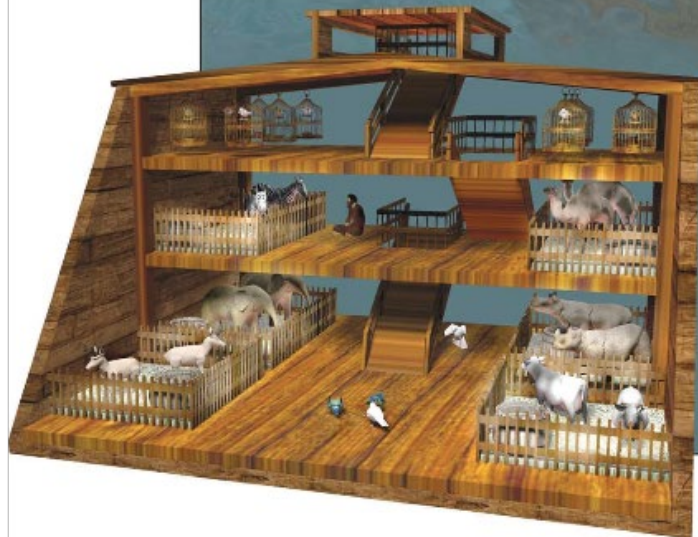
INSIDE THE ARK

The ark was built with three decks and provisioned by Noah for himself and his family and every kind of bird and animal as God commanded:

- 7 pairs * each of all clean animals
- 7 pairs each of all birds of the air
- 2 pair each of all unclean animals

*pair denotes 1 male and 1 female



I Tim. 1:4—Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: *so do*.

In the YouTube video, ANTEDILUVIAN PERIOD: WHAT WAS THE WORLD LIKE BEFORE THE FLOOD it is stated that no credence can be given in determining the age of this period based upon genealogies. We'll also consider the New Testament verse above. When God gives us the genealogy in Genesis 5, it stands out and above those genealogies simply mentioning ancestral descent. Consider the uniqueness of the Genesis 5 genealogy:

1. Begetting age of each individual is given
2. Longevity of each individual is revealed
3. Ancestral descent cited
4. Adam's link to the original creation is evident. This gives us an exact date, in years, from creation to the flood or destruction of the old world.
5. Adam's genealogy does not create a question but rather it establishes the veracity of God's word by providing an indispensable link between the antediluvian world and the world that followed—between the idyllic and one cursed by man's sin
