## REVIVAL STIRS 'COLONEL ZACK'

Harvey Fritts, in Western Garb,  
Among Throngs at Rites

Humbly and joyously, additional throngs of persons lifted their hands in testimony of their new acceptance of Jesus as Evangelist Billy Graham returned yesterday to the Christ for Greater Los Angeles revival. After a single day's rest from nearly six weeks' nightly sermons, the 30-year-old Rev. Dr. Graham's message drew scores to the prayer tent for individual help.

### ALL WALKS

There, on their knees in the sawdust, were people of every age and walk of life, joined in the single purpose of prayer.

Among them was Harvey Fritts, in the Western garb he wears as "Colonel Zack" in the starring role of his television show.

"As a young man I drifted away from the Bible," he testified. "A week ago a lady asked me to come here and hear Billy Graham.

"I still fought against being a Christian, but as he spoke I finally admitted to myself I could not oppose the will of God."

Like many others of the more than 5000 who have testified to their finding again the teachings of Christ in the big tent at Washington and Hill street, "things began happening" to Fritts.

### FINDS COUSIN

From among the nearly 250,000 people who have attended the services, he found a cousin he had not seen in 25 years, and the cousin put him in touch with his own family, virtual strangers more than a dozen years.

With the nightly 7:30 o'clock meetings continuing indefinitely by public demand, the scene of fervent faith was described by
