4.1. Registration fee:

The initial annual one-time non-refundable registration fee is R 1 200.00.

4.2. Monthly fee:

A fee of **R 3 900-00** (Full Day) will be payable monthly in advance, this includes December. December is seen as a full calendar month.

There will be no refunds for missed days, sick days, public holidays etc.

Payments must be made on or before the 1st of each month.

No late payments will be tolerated.

A 5% discount is given for 12 months prepayment.

Times

Staff will be on duty from Monday – Friday: From 06:30 – 17:30 NO parents will be allowed access to the property before 06:30.

Upon arrival, parents should hand over their child to the caregiver at the front door. After that, their breakfast will be served at 8:00 a.m. and the daily program will begin.

PLEASE NOTE:

Parents will need to notify management/the school in advance if someone else picks up the child from the school who is not listed as someone who may pick up the child.

Management will require a written letter, signed by the parent, with a detailed description of the person and, if possible, a photocopy of their ID.

Any parent who collects their child later than 17H30 will be charged a fine of R100 per child for every 15 minutes or part thereof they are late, which is CASH payable upon collection.

Absence

Parents should notify the Management of Mini Kids if any child is absent due to illness, hospitalization etc...

Cancellations

For the cancellation of any child, management will need a written request and a month's notice. If this is not possible, 1 month school fees must be paid in place of the notice, this is not negotiable.

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Sick children

A child who has any of the following illnesses will not be allowed on the school grounds. These include but are not limited to Chickenpox, Mumps, Measles, German Measles, Rubella, Scarlet Fever, Hepatitis, RS Virus, tonsillitis, Gastro, High temperatures, vomiting, diarrhoea, severe headache, LICE.

Mini Kids has a first aid facility that is only for treatment purposes if a child is sick. Please note that the facility is simply a form of observation for a sick individual waiting to be collected.

A parent will be notified once a child has been sent to the office due to illness.

Management will then contact the parents to arrange the collection of the sick child. Please note that sending a sick child to school poses a great risk to the child, teacher, other learners, and our staff.

DO NOT bring your child to school if he/she suffers from any of the above.

No child should be at school for the first 3 days of antibiotic treatment.

<u>Please remember</u>

Notify management immediately if any personal or contact details have changed. Please be so kind as to return any toys or items in your child's bag that do not belong to your child.

Mini Kids Are Closed

The school closes each year for the December holidays and reopens in early January.

If a holiday falls on a Tuesday or Thursday, school will also be closed the day before/after.
