The KRLC Church Council: Regarding Property Policy and Kitchen use. A motion was made, seconded and passed for the Julebyen Festival which will be held in December, 2024:

It has been Approved for the *Julebyen Festival* to use the KRLC Kitchen depending on the issue of a Food License by Lake County. This is subject to the Building Use Policy as stated in the Minutes of 5/19/24 This Policy was passed at that time, and reads:

Building Policy Update, It was decided that if a Vendor has a Lake County license and it has been accepted by Lake County, KRLC will accept that Lake County License, and it will suffice for the use of the kitchen at KRLC. This is an update in our Policy Guideline on page 4 of 9 pages.

There is a need for the Property Policy to be reviewed for others uses by Church Members. IE: Baby Showers, etc. There seems to be confusion in this area.
