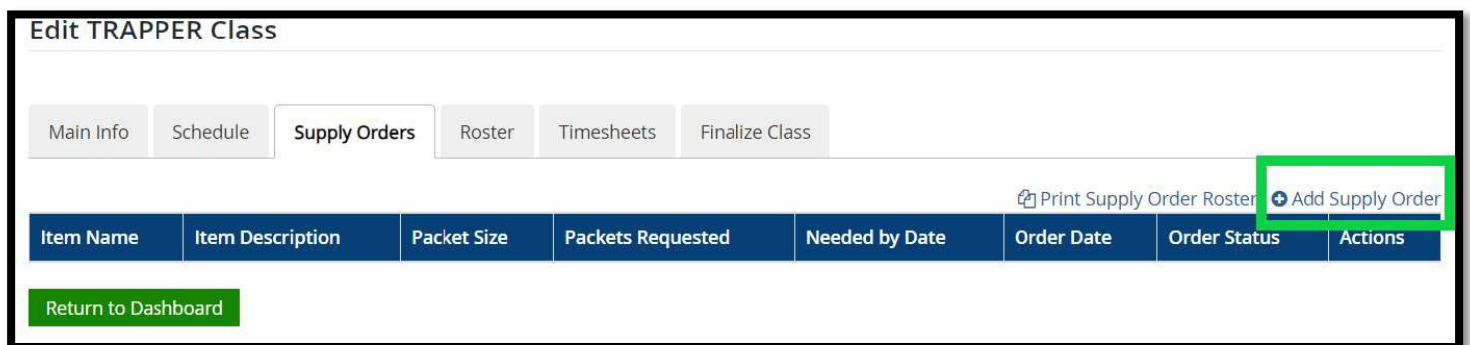


After creating your class, you will see a supply order tab.



Click on Add Supply Order to open up the next screen. You will go through the Add Supply Order link for each time you need to order until you have all the items you need.

Add Supply Order

Please select from the dropdown menu to see the available options for supplies. Descriptions of what is included will appear once you select an option. Each supply order is limited to the max number of students you entered on the Main Info tab – we do allow you to order 5 more than the max number of students in case you need additional supplies for instructors, etc.

If you would like to place an order outside of the available options or you only need some of the materials, please contact your Outdoor Skills Trainer.

YOU MUST ORDER SUPPLIES AT LEAST 4 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF THE CLASS START DATE TO ALLOW FOR PROCESSING. IF YOU ARE WITHIN 4 WEEKS OF THE START DATE, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SUBMIT A SUPPLY ORDER - YOU MUST CONTACT YOUR OUTDOOR SKILLS TRAINER TO CONTINUE WITH YOUR CLASS.

You can proceed with the class but are not allowed to complete a supply order unless you contact your OST for further information.

If you enter in a needed by date and receive the following message, this means the date you entered is within 4 weeks which doesn't give the processing center time to process and ship your order. You can still offer your class but will need to contact Shawn or Erin to make arrangements to get supplies. PLEASE ensure you are creating your class and ordering supplies out at least 4 weeks to prevent the extra workload.
