Stop Scotch Broom.

This invasive shrub has infested Lummi Island and poses a huge FIRE RISK to our community. Help stop the invasion!

Why is Scotch broom so bad?

Scotch broom devastates native landscapes and is EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE.



It has a HIGH OIL CONTENT, spreads rapidly, and forms dense stands.

The plant INCREASES FIRE INTENSITY AND DURATION and can boost flames into the tree canopy.



FACT: Lummi Island is at HIGH RISK OF CATASTROPHIC LOSS from fire.



How can you help protect Lummi Island?

Removing Scotch broom from your property will improve our ecosystem health and reduce our wildfire risk!
