"According to Apartments.com's third-quarter report, asking rents nationally declined by 0.4%. CoStar Group National Director of Multifamily Analytics Jay Lybick said it was the weakest Q3 for multifamily in 30 years."

A quote from the article:

[Robert Dietz, chief economist, National Association of Home Builders (NAHB)] said the single-family rental industry, or "horizontal multifamily" currently, roughly 5% to 6% of new single-family homes built are occupied by renters and 5% to 6% are bought by investors and converted to single-family rentals.

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"Historically, this has been about 3% of the single-family home sector, but now it's about one in 10 homes, and maybe more, and the number is forecast to increase."

If rent control is put into place, those homes that are now rented out (and that have recently become a significant part of the inventory of homes) will be converted away from rentals and back to owner occupied dwellings which will further impact rental supply and further skew the supply/demand imbalance.

NAR: NAR opposes rent control for the following reasons:

- \cdot $\,$ $\,$ Property owners have the right to set rents at market rate.
- Property owners have the right to own property free of unreasonable controls.
- Rent control and rent stabilization put unreasonable costs and burdens upon property owners without compensation.
- Rent control and rent stabilization create market distortions and allocate housing inefficiently.

• The social responsibility of providing affordable housing should not be disproportionately borne by private property owners.

- Rent control has been shown to be extremely difficult and costly to administer by local governments.
- Lost revenue under rent control measures reduces the ability for the property owner to maintain and improve the property.

• As residential rentals lose value due to the restriction on rents, property tax assessments decrease along with the property tax base. Therefore, other property owners would eventually pay more in taxes or fees as a result.

Rent control discourages the production of new rental dwellings in the private sector.

Developer thoughts (J)

- Developers recognized the shortage in 2019, and have responded by developing close to 1,500 market rate units which are currently under construction and set for delivery in the next 18 months and another 1,000 breaking ground in the next year. Considering that the city delivered 56 units in 2019, 140 in 2020, 200 in 2021, and looking like 40 in 2022, this is a remarkable response from the private sector. This added supply will provide downward pressure on existing communities and halt the rent growth trend. This does not even take into account the Build For Rent single family developments on the horizon and there are well over 1,000 units expected from that space
- Developers have been creating new housing through motel conversions which have brought on over 500 affordably priced units in the past 3 years. Todd you may have more specific numbers than I do... We need additional support from CABQ to make this by right without having to do zone changes to remodel these properties into housing. This is the fastest way to provide affordable housing and requires no financial assistance from the government.
- Rent growth is on a considerable downward trend. Rent growth was 18% in February 2022 and is currently at 10.6% during the peak leasing season. The days of crazy rent growth are about over
- As part of the incentive portion for creating housing, the city should be promoting and expanding the use of Metropolitan Redevelopment Areas. They should create new districts all over the city that are primed for redevelopment, Cottonwood mall, North I-25 area north of Alameda, Montgomery, Lomas, Menaul, etc.

Palindrome Properties financially closed in September on Trailhead at Chamizal, a 204-apartment property on 6.1 acres in Albuquerque, New Mexico. HCP invested \$19.1 million in federal LIHTC equity in the development. Palindrome also plans to develop a neighboring hotel, urban farm, workshop, grocery store and market-rate multifamily project. The \$58.6 million development, which will host those earning up to 60% of the AMI, is due for completion in late 2024. Bank of the West and Boston Capital provided loans.
