Constitution of Lesedi House of Faith

A Ministry Expression of Healing the Faith Ministry

Preamble

Lesedi House of Faith exists as a Christ-centred Apostolic and prophetic house under the broader vision and spiritual covering of Healing the Faith Ministry — committed to restoring faith, healing spiritual and emotional wounds, discipling believers, equipping leaders, and advancing the Kingdom of God.

We, the members and leadership of Lesedi House of Faith, acknowledging Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and recognising the authority of the Holy Scriptures, hereby establish this Constitution to govern the spiritual, administrative, and operational affairs of the ministry.

This Constitution serves to preserve order, accountability, unity, integrity, and alignment with the ministry's vision and Biblical foundation.

Name and Status

2.1 Name

The name of the ministry shall be **Lesedi House of Faith** (hereinafter referred to as "Lesedi House" or "the Ministry").

2.2 Relationship to Healing the Faith Ministry

Lesedi House of Faith operates as a ministry expression and affiliated church under the broader vision and spiritual covering of Healing the Faith Ministry, maintaining operational functionality as a local church and Apostolic house.

2.3 Legal Status

The Ministry may register in terms of the applicable laws of the Republic of South Africa as:

- A Non-Profit Organisation (NPO)
- Non-Profit Company (NPC)
- Trust
- Any other lawful structure deemed appropriate by leadership

The Ministry shall exist as a separate legal entity where applicable and may acquire, hold, lease, or dispose of property in accordance with applicable laws.



Vision

A House of Light, Faith & Healing

To be a house of light, faith, healing, and spiritual formation where believers are restored, disciplined, equipped, and empowered to walk fully in their God-given purpose.

Mission

The mission of Lesedi House of Faith is to advance the Kingdom of God through the following commitments:



Preach & Teach

To preach and teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ with clarity and conviction.



Restore

To restore wounded and spiritually burdened individuals through pastoral care.



Disciple

To disciple believers into spiritual maturity and holiness.



Equip Leaders

To identify, mentor, and equip leaders and ministers for Kingdom service.

→ Prayer, Worship & Holiness

To cultivate a life of prayer, worship, holiness, and obedience to God.

→ Holy Spirit Guidance

To operate in the gifts and guidance of the Holy Spirit in accordance with Scripture.

→ Unity in the Body of Christ

To promote unity within the Body of Christ while remaining grounded in Biblical truth.

Objectives

The objectives of the Ministry include a broad range of spiritual, pastoral, and community-focused activities:

Worship & Prayer

- 1** Conducting worship services, prayer meetings, teachings, conferences, and outreach programmes.

Pastoral Support

- 2** Providing counselling, healing, and pastoral support to individuals and families.

Leadership Development

- 3** Supporting spiritual growth and leadership development within the Ministry.

Community Upliftment

- 4** Advancing charitable, educational, and community upliftment initiatives where appropriate.

Collaboration

- 5** Collaborating with other ministries and churches in furtherance of the Gospel.

Statement of Faith

Lesedi House of Faith affirms and believes the following foundational truths of the Christian faith:

The Triune God

In one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Jesus Christ

That Jesus Christ is the Son of God, crucified, resurrected, and returning again.

Salvation by Grace

That salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

Holy Scriptures

In the authority, truth, and sufficiency of the Holy Scriptures as the Word of God.

The Holy Spirit

In the ministry and active work of the Holy Spirit, including prayer, healing, deliverance, and restoration.

The Body of Christ & Eternal Life

In the unity of believers, water baptism, Holy Communion, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal life.

- ③ The Ministry acknowledges the operation of spiritual gifts, including prophecy, discernment, healing, exhortation, teaching, and other gifts as provided for in Scripture and exercised in decency and order.

Values

The Ministry shall uphold the following core values in all its activities, leadership, and community life:



Christ-Centred Leadership

All leadership flows from and points to Jesus Christ.



Integrity & Accountability

Transparent, honest, and accountable conduct at every level.



Love & Compassion

Serving one another and the community with genuine love.



Healing & Restoration

Creating a safe space for spiritual and emotional healing.



Biblical Truth

Grounded in the unchanging truth of God's Word.



Servanthood

Modelling the servant heart of Jesus in all we do.



Prayer & Spiritual Discipline

Committed to a lifestyle of prayer and spiritual formation.



Respect for Human Dignity

Honouring the God-given worth of every individual.



Unity in the Body of Christ

Pursuing oneness across the broader Church of Jesus Christ.

Membership

6.1 Eligibility

Membership shall be open to all persons who:

- Confess Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour
- Support the vision and values of the Ministry
- Commit to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with Biblical principles

6.2 Rights and Responsibilities

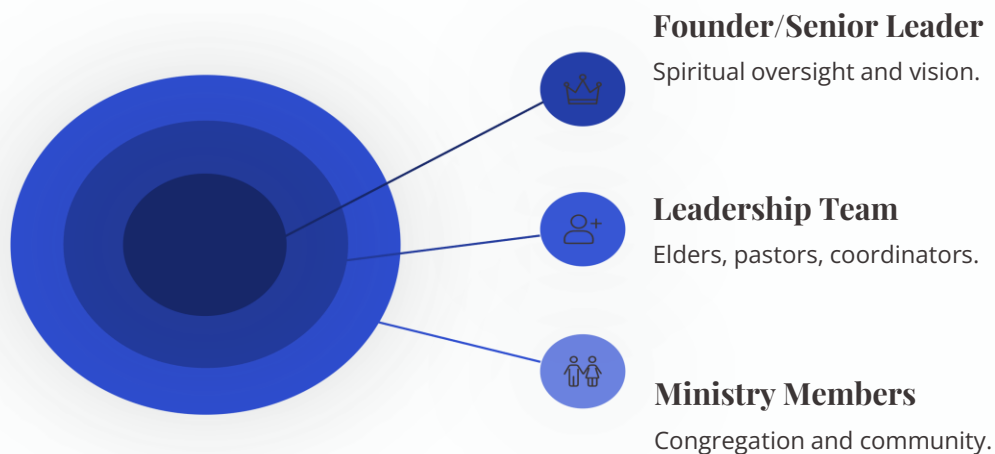
Members shall:

- Participate in the life and activities of the Ministry
- Uphold unity and respect within Lesedi House
- Conduct themselves with integrity and Christian character
- Support the work of the Ministry spiritually and practically

6.3 Discipline

Where conduct is deemed harmful to the Ministry, its members, or inconsistent with Biblical standards, leadership may implement corrective and restorative measures in accordance with Scripture, fairness, and pastoral sensitivity.

Leadership and Governance



The Ministry shall be led under the spiritual oversight of the Founder/Senior Leader and such leadership structures as may be established from time to time, ensuring alignment with Healing the Faith Ministry at all levels.

Roles of the Founder / Senior Leader

The Founder/Senior Leader holds the primary spiritual authority and responsibility for the direction of Lesedi House of Faith:

- 
Safeguard Vision & Doctrine
 Protect and preserve the founding vision and doctrinal integrity of the Ministry.
- 
Provide Spiritual Direction
 Offer ongoing spiritual oversight, guidance, and direction to the entire Ministry.
- 
Appoint or Remove Leaders
 Appoint or remove ministry leaders where necessary in accordance with the Ministry's values.
- 
Ensure Alignment
 Ensure ongoing alignment with the vision and principles of Healing the Faith Ministry.

The Ministry may establish the following leadership structures:



7.4 Leadership Conduct

All leaders shall uphold the following standards of conduct:

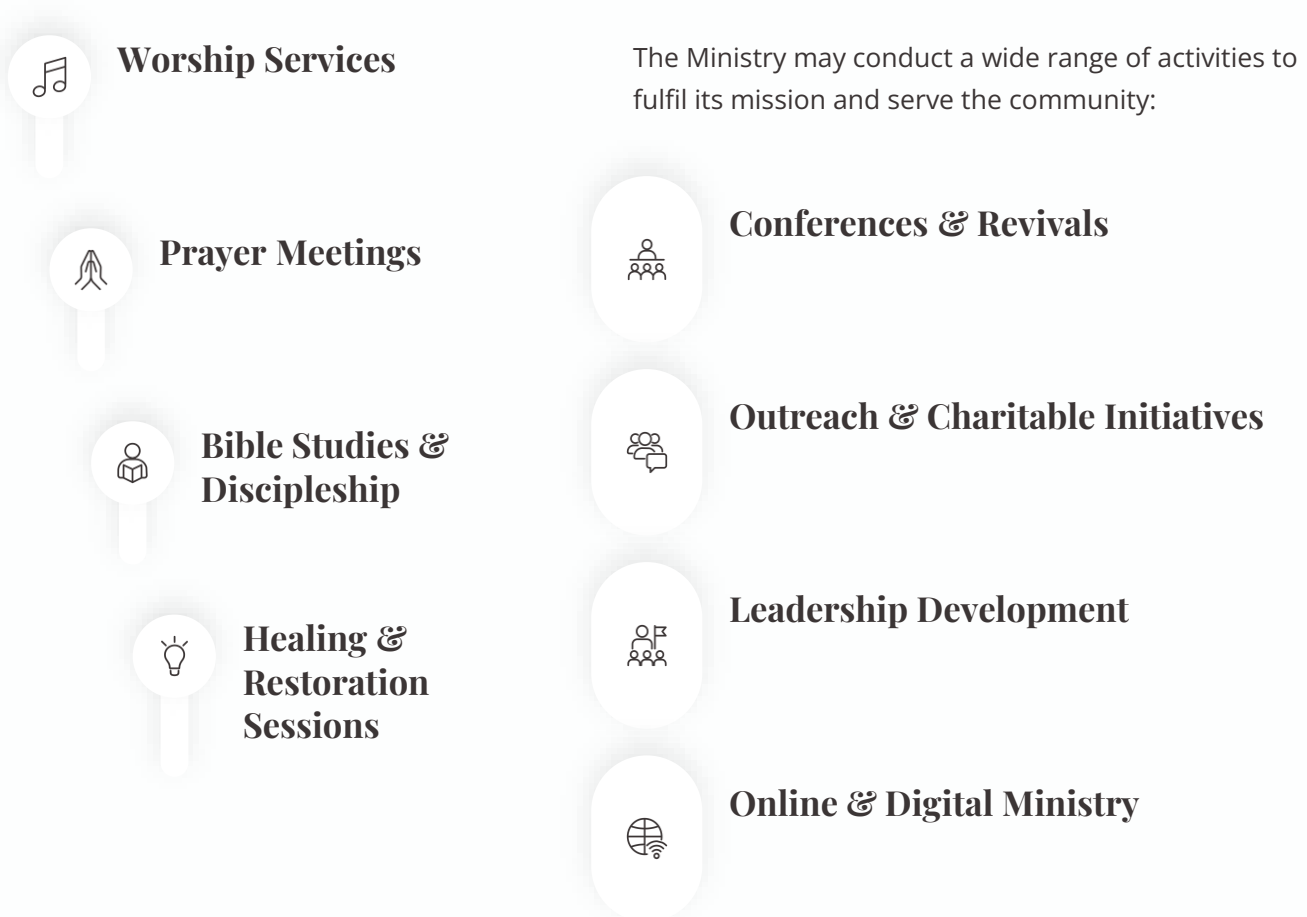
- Serve with humility, integrity, and accountability
- Avoid abusive, manipulative, or exploitative conduct
- Respect confidentiality in all pastoral matters
- Conduct themselves in a manner becoming of Christian leadership

 Leadership appointments shall be based on spiritual maturity, integrity, gifting, and alignment with the Ministry's vision and values.

MINISTRY ACTIVITIES

Ministry Activities

The Ministry may conduct a wide range of activities to fulfil its mission and serve the community:



Financial Management

9.1 Financial Resources

The Ministry may receive:

- Tithes
- Offerings
- Donations
- Grants
- Fundraising proceeds
- Other lawful income

9.2 Use of Funds

All funds shall be used solely to further the objectives of the Ministry and shall not be distributed for personal gain except for lawful remuneration or reimbursements approved by leadership.

9.3 Banking and Financial Controls

- The Ministry shall maintain a bank account in its registered name where applicable
- Proper accounting records shall be maintained at all times
- Financial oversight mechanisms shall be implemented
- Signatories and approval processes shall be determined by leadership

Property and Assets

The Ministry may acquire, lease, hold, or dispose of movable and immovable property in accordance with applicable laws and governance processes.

- ✓ Any property or assets acquired shall be used solely for the advancement of the Ministry's objectives — ensuring that all resources serve the Kingdom of God and the community Lesedi House of Faith is called to serve.

Relationship with Other Churches and Ministries

Acknowledgement

Lesedi House of Faith acknowledges the wider Body of Christ and may collaborate with churches, ministries, and organisations whose activities align with Biblical principles and the vision of the Ministry.

Posture

The Ministry shall maintain a posture of unity, respect, and reconciliation in all inter-church and inter-ministry relationships.

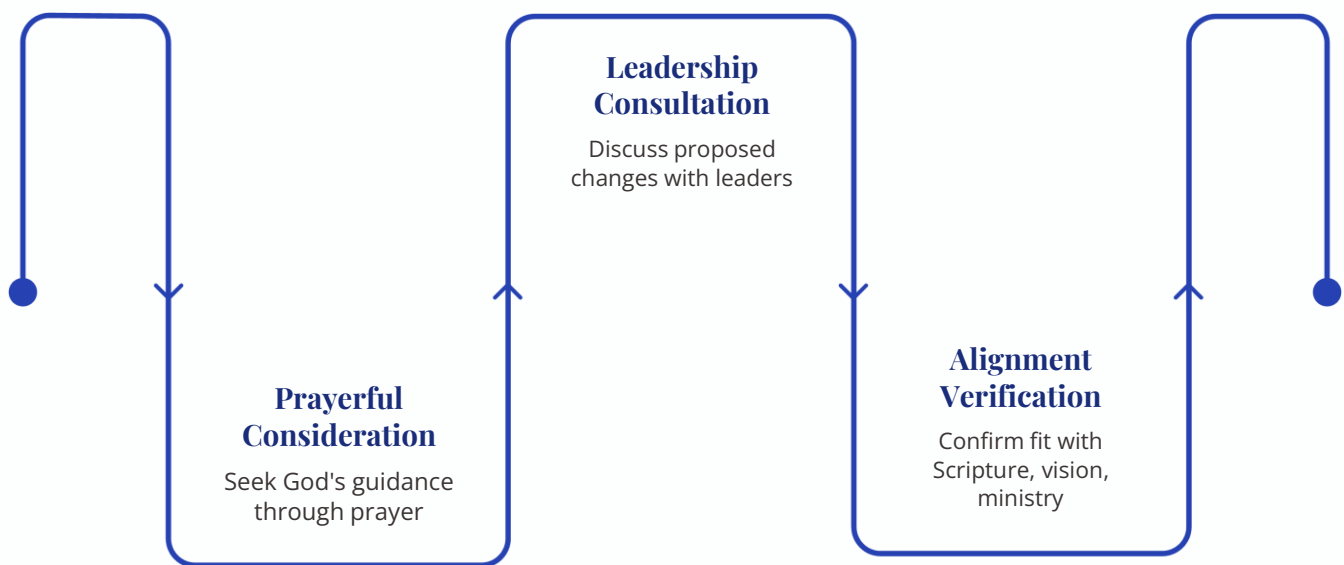
Integrity

While pursuing collaboration and unity, the Ministry shall preserve its doctrinal integrity and remain grounded in Biblical truth at all times.

Amendments to the Constitution

This Constitution may be amended by the leadership of the Ministry following prayerful consideration and consultation where appropriate.

 Any amendments must remain aligned with the Holy Scriptures, the vision and values of the Ministry, and the foundational principles of Healing the Faith Ministry.



Dissolution

In the event of the dissolution of Lesedi House of Faith, the following principles shall govern the process:

Settle All Liabilities

All outstanding liabilities of the Ministry shall first be settled in full.

Transfer Remaining Assets

Any remaining assets shall be transferred to Healing the Faith Ministry or another non-profit Christian ministry with similar objectives, as determined by leadership and applicable law.

No Personal Benefit

No member or individual shall personally benefit from the dissolution of the Ministry under any circumstances.
