There are state grant programs that can provide landowners with technical and financial assistance to thin privately owned forested land and/or create defensible space around homes.

The main objectives of the Nogal Canyon WUI (Wildland Urban Interface) Cost Share Programs are to mitigate fire risk while improving forest health. These grant opportunities can reimburse program participants for up to 50% of the cost to treat private land.
