## ATTENTION LIVESTOCK SCALE OWNERS! NEW Routine Livestock Scale Inspection Program

The New Mexico Department of Agriculture Standards and Consumer Services Division (SCS) ensures the accuracy of your livestock scale(s) each year. In order to improve our efficiency, we are asking our livestock scale owners to become part of the routine livestock scale inspection program. It will be mandatory for all livestock scale owners to maintain current contact information with our office. This includes names, phone numbers, cell phone numbers, mailing addresses and most importantly, email addresses, as this will serve as the main point of communication for future updates, new information, and inspector correspondence.

#### Rules for the routine livestock program

- Scales MUST be ready for inspection January 1 through December 31 each year.
- Scales unable to be tested due to missing indicators, excessive weeds, unkempt beam boxes, blocked approaches, locked gates, etc., will be placed "Out of Order."
- Re-inspections of a scale will be assessed a charge according to the current SCS fee schedule, which may be found at https://nmdeptag.nmsu.edu/standardsand-consumer-services/scs-main.html
- Scales tagged "Out of Order" or "No Test" for any reason will be removed from the program list.
- It is the scale owner's responsibility or a licensed repair establishment to contact NMDA once the scale has been repaired. After a "Placed in Service" report has been received by our office, the scale will be added back onto the routine livestock program list.

# What do I need to do if I chose NOT to be part of the routine livestock program and choose to request annually?

- You must contact NMDA annually to request a scale inspection.
- Inspection requests must be made January 1 through March 31 of the current inspection year.
- Late requests (after March 31) will be assessed a charge according to the current SCS fee schedule.
- Scales unable to be tested due to missing indicators, excessive weeds, unkempt beam boxes, blocked approaches, locked gates, etc., will be placed "Out of Order."
- Re-inspections of a scale will be assessed a charge according to the current SCS fee schedule.







### Becoming part of the routine livestock scale inspection program

- (1) Complete and submit the Routine Livestock Scale Inspection Form available on the NMDA website https://nmdeptag.nmsu.edu/media/pdf/livestock-scale-form.pdf or call us at 575-646-1616 to have a form emailed to you.
- 2 The Routine Livestock Scale Inspection Form must be submitted by March 31 of the current year.
- 3 Once we have received your Routine Livestock Scale Inspection Form, you will receive an email confirmation and be registered into the program.
- The Routine Livestock Scale Inspection Form serves as consent for NMDA staff to be on the property for livestock scale inspection.
