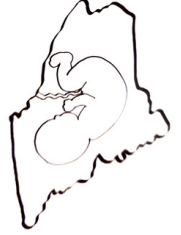

State of Maine Car Seat Program

What is it?

The Bureau of Highway Safety has partner locations around the State of Maine where income eligible families can make an appointment with a certified car seat technician to obtain a car seat.

How do I request a car seat?

What are the eligibility requirements?

1. **Eligibility requirements** - participants must receive and provide proof of **ONE** of the following:

a. eWIC card
b. MaineCare letter
c. TANF
d. SNAP

OR

a current dated letter of correspondence from either of the agencies to the family, confirming participation

2. **Residency requirements** - provide **ONE** of the following (non-expired):

a. State of Maine Driver's License
b. State of Maine Identification
c. Maine Tribal Identification
d. Fostering license/certification

e. High School Photo ID Card
f. Letter of Refugee accompanied by the Refugee's photo and I-94 number

**Should you not have one of the above, please contact a Distribution center for assistance.

What seats are provided?

For children 5 - 65 lbs and under 54":
Evenflo Titan 65/SureRide

For children 55 - 120 lbs and 44" - 57":
Evenflo GoTime Booster

I've completed my request, now what?

Once **Livin' the Breast Life, LLC** has a seat for you, they will reach out and schedule a pick-up appointment. You will need proof of eligibility and residency at that appointment. Should you have any questions, please reach out to the facility directly.

NOTES: This service is available by **appointment only**. Make sure to plan ahead, there may be a slight wait time to meet with a technician. Your child will need to be present during the appointment.

The **wait time is typically 6-8 weeks** due to needing to order the car seats from the manufacturer. This is assuming there are no delays in shipping.

For expecting families, the appointment **cannot** be scheduled more than one month before the due date.
